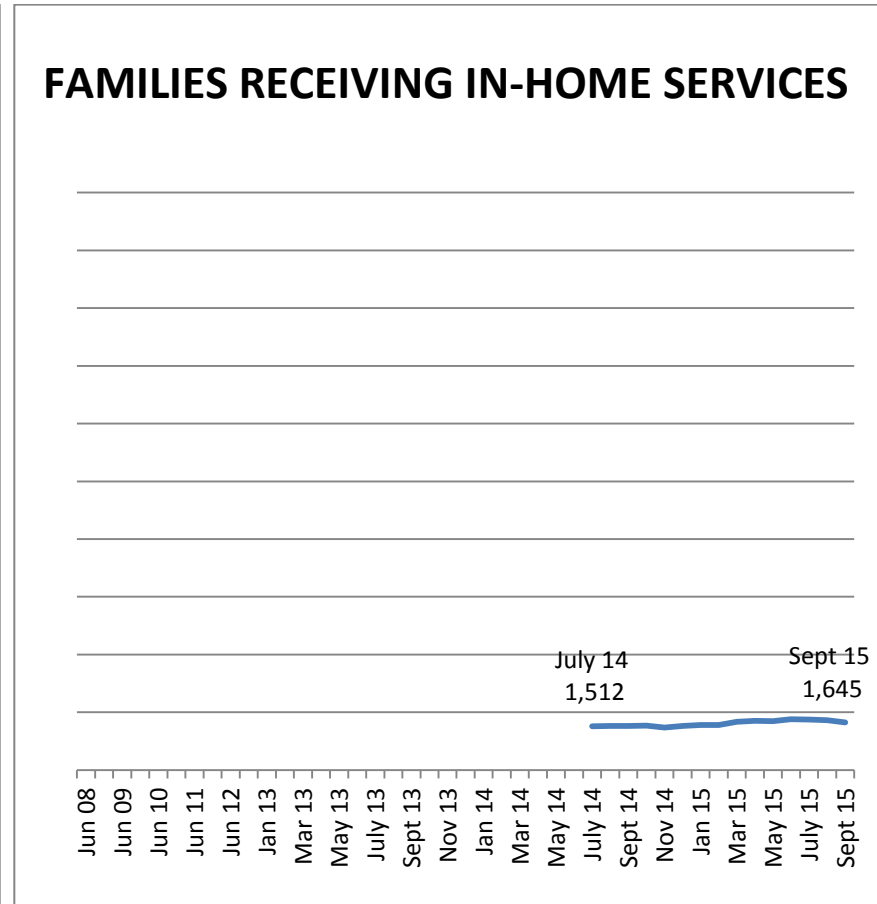

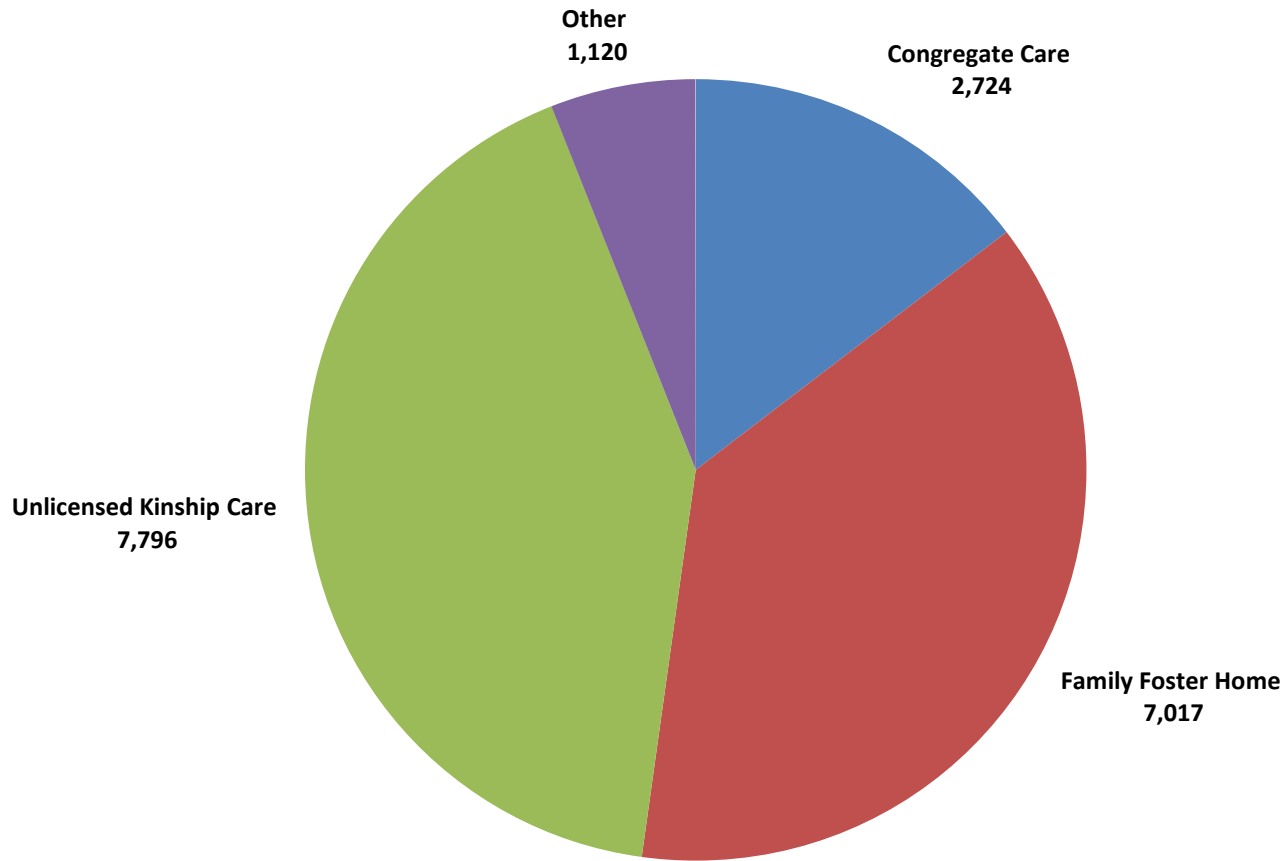

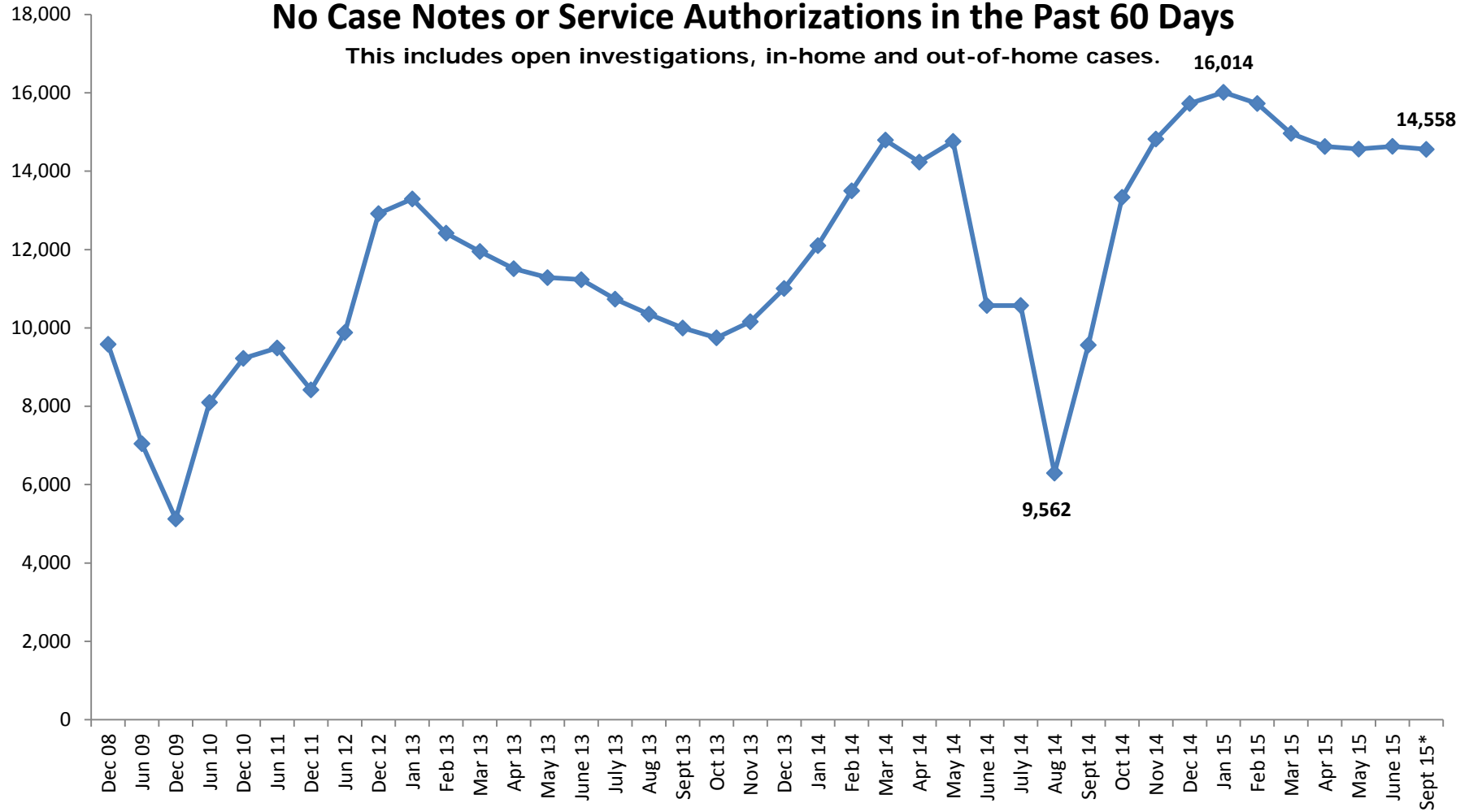

### No Case Notes or Service Authorizations in the Past 60 Days

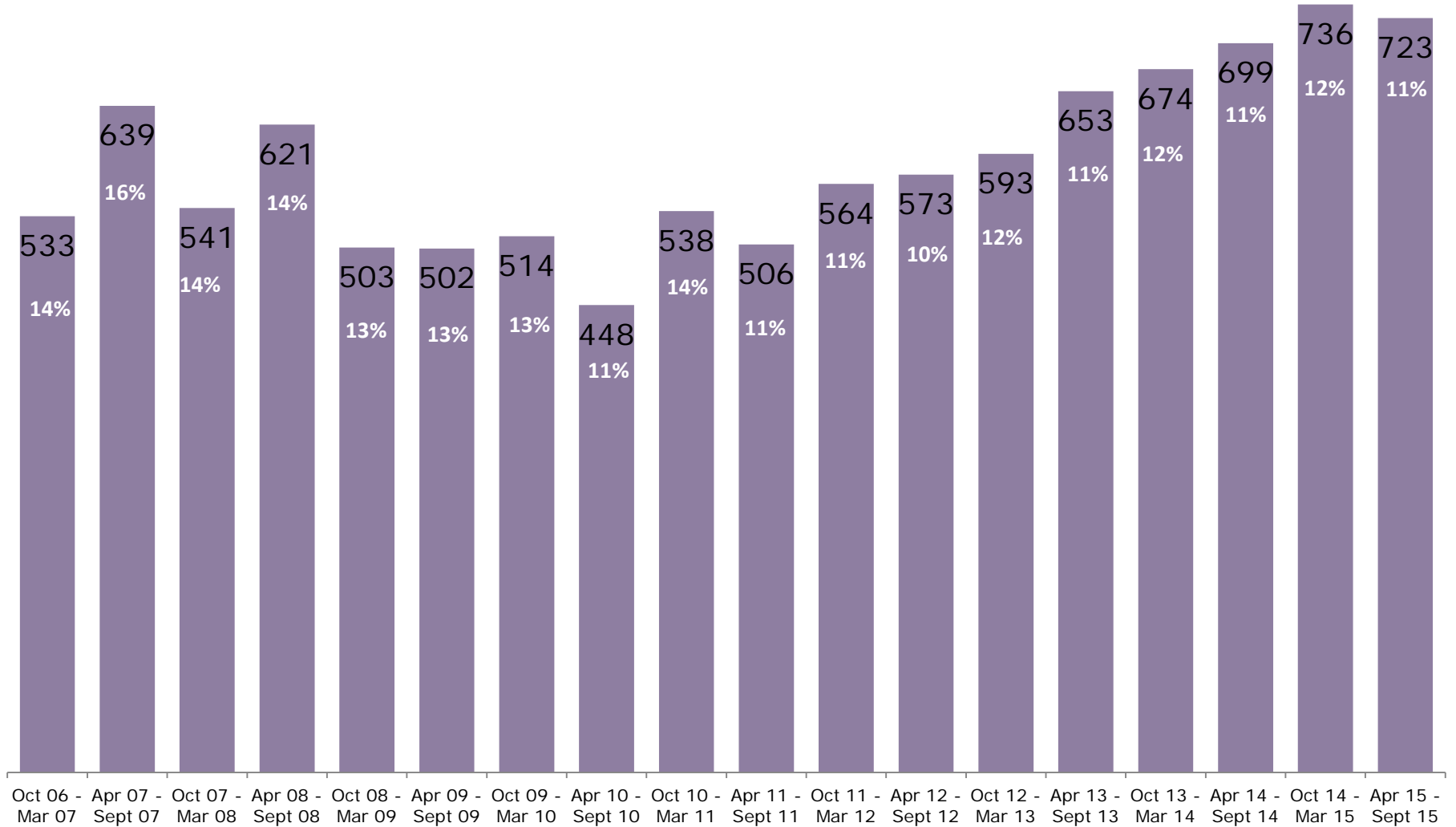

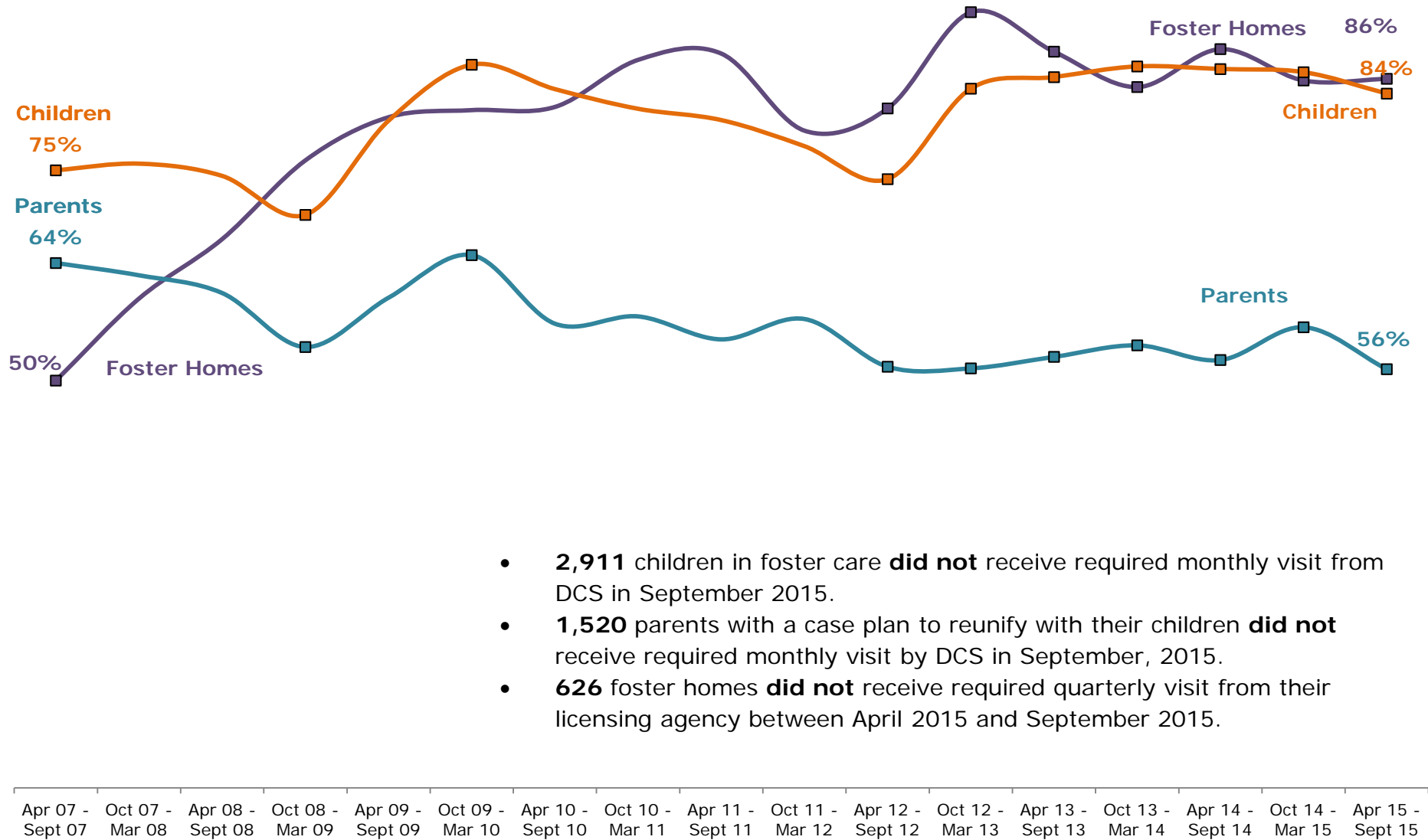
### Kids entering foster care with a previous removal in the last 24 months

## Receiving Required Visits for Children in Foster Care



- **2,911** children in foster care **did not** receive required monthly visit from DCS in September 2015.
- **1,520** parents with a case plan to reunify with their children **did not** receive required monthly visit by DCS in September, 2015.
- **626** foster homes **did not** receive required quarterly visit from their licensing agency between April 2015 and September 2015.

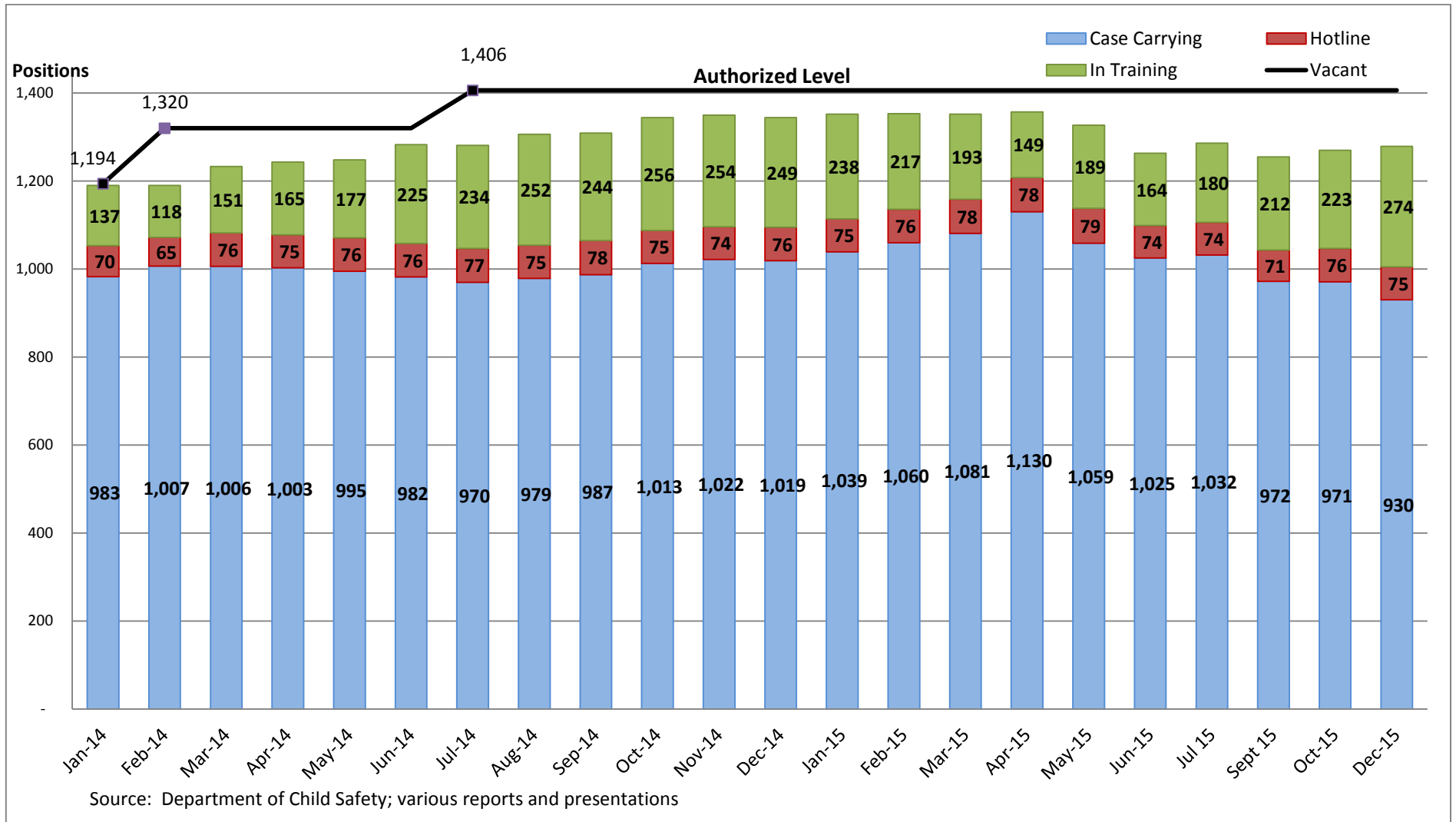

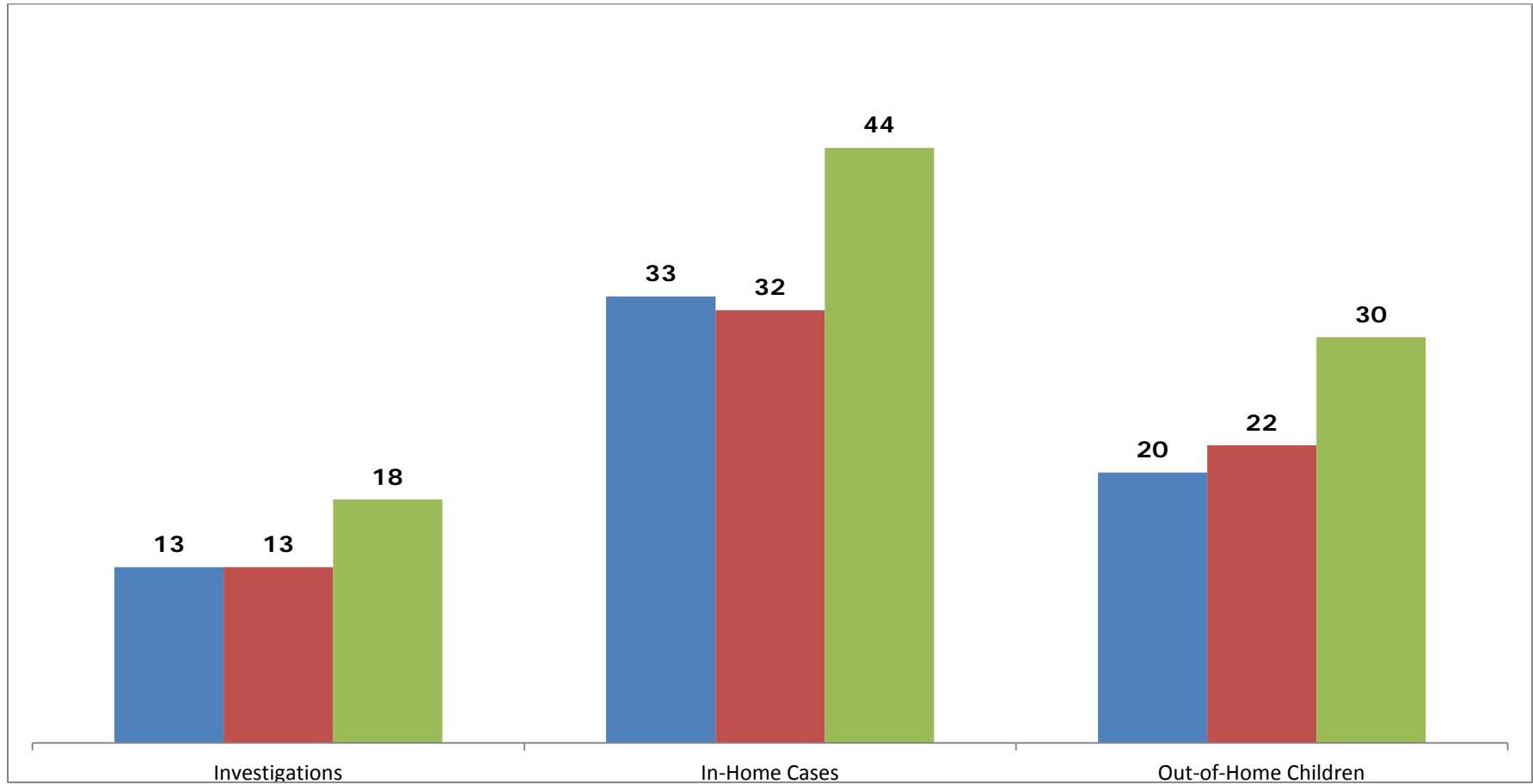

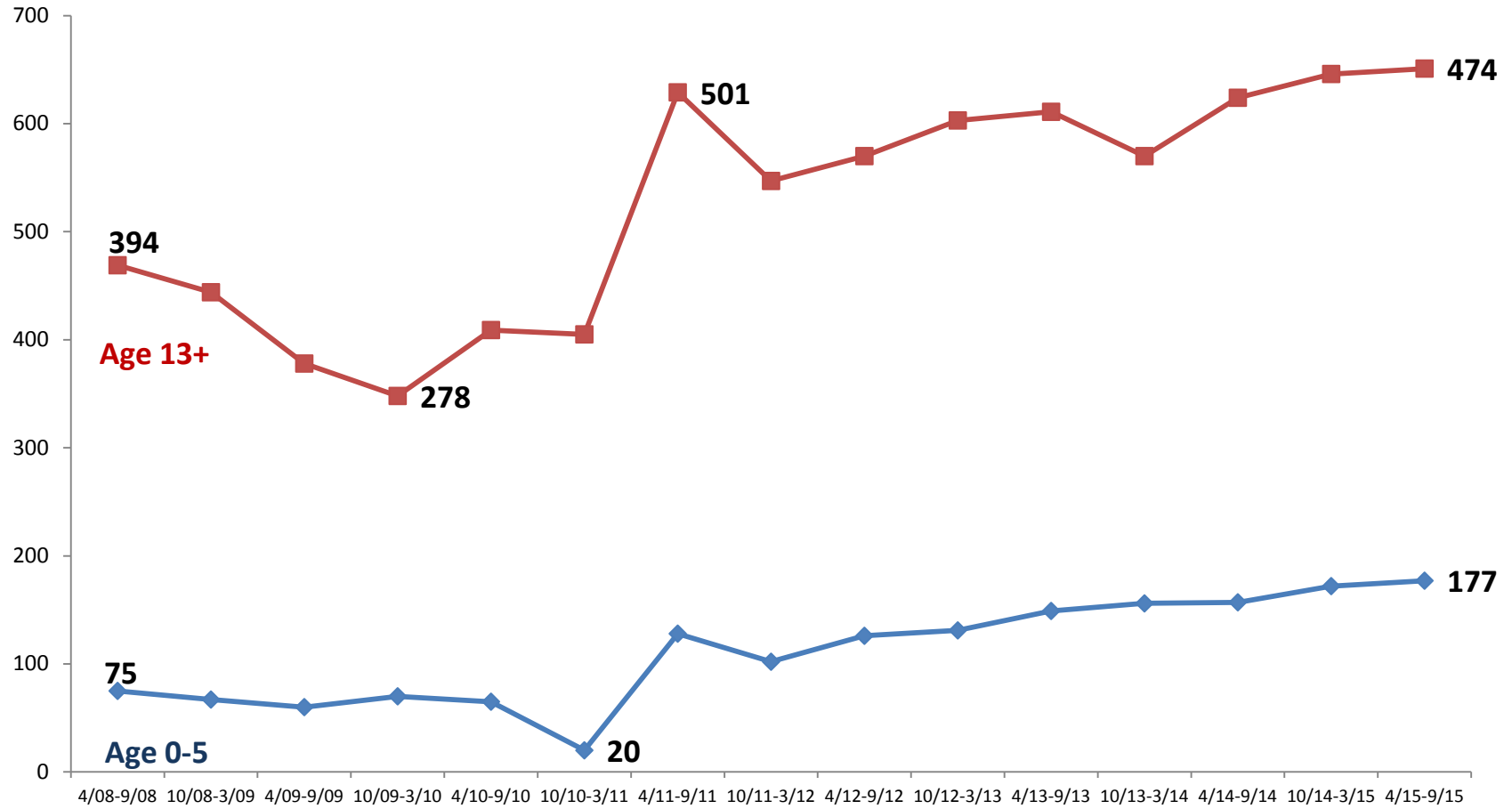

## Number of Children in Shelter Care for More than 21 Consecutive Days By Age

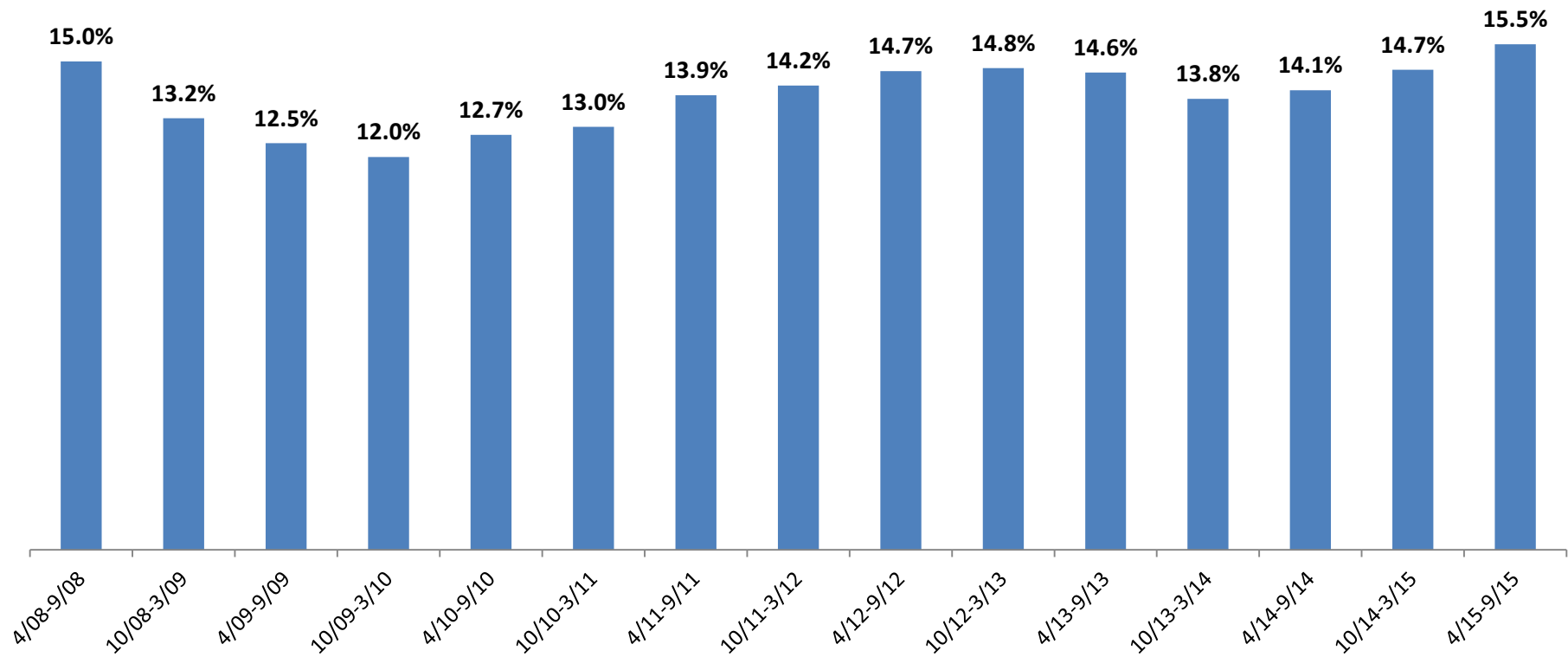

## Percentage of Children in Out-of-Home Care in Group Homes or Residential Treatment

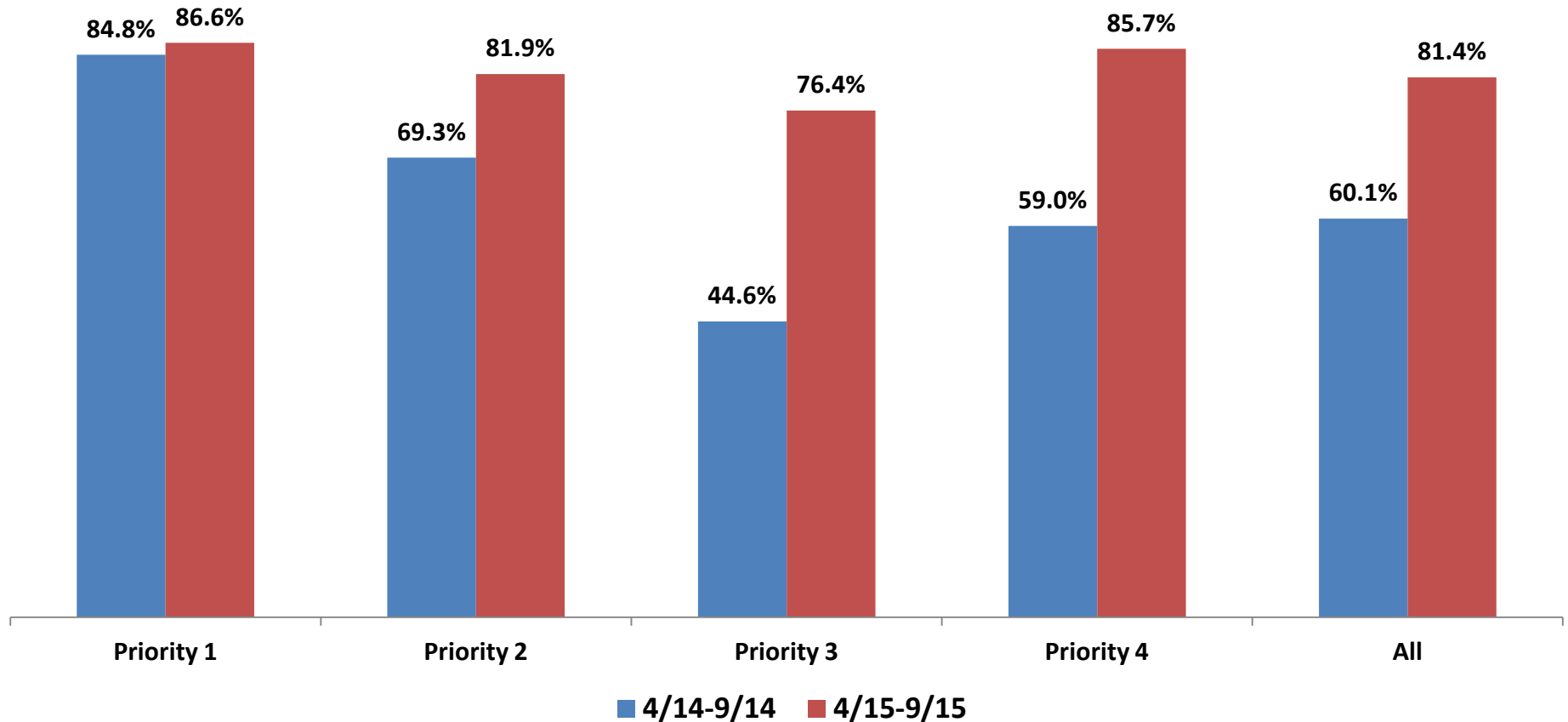

## Statewide Percentage of Cases Where Response Was Timely



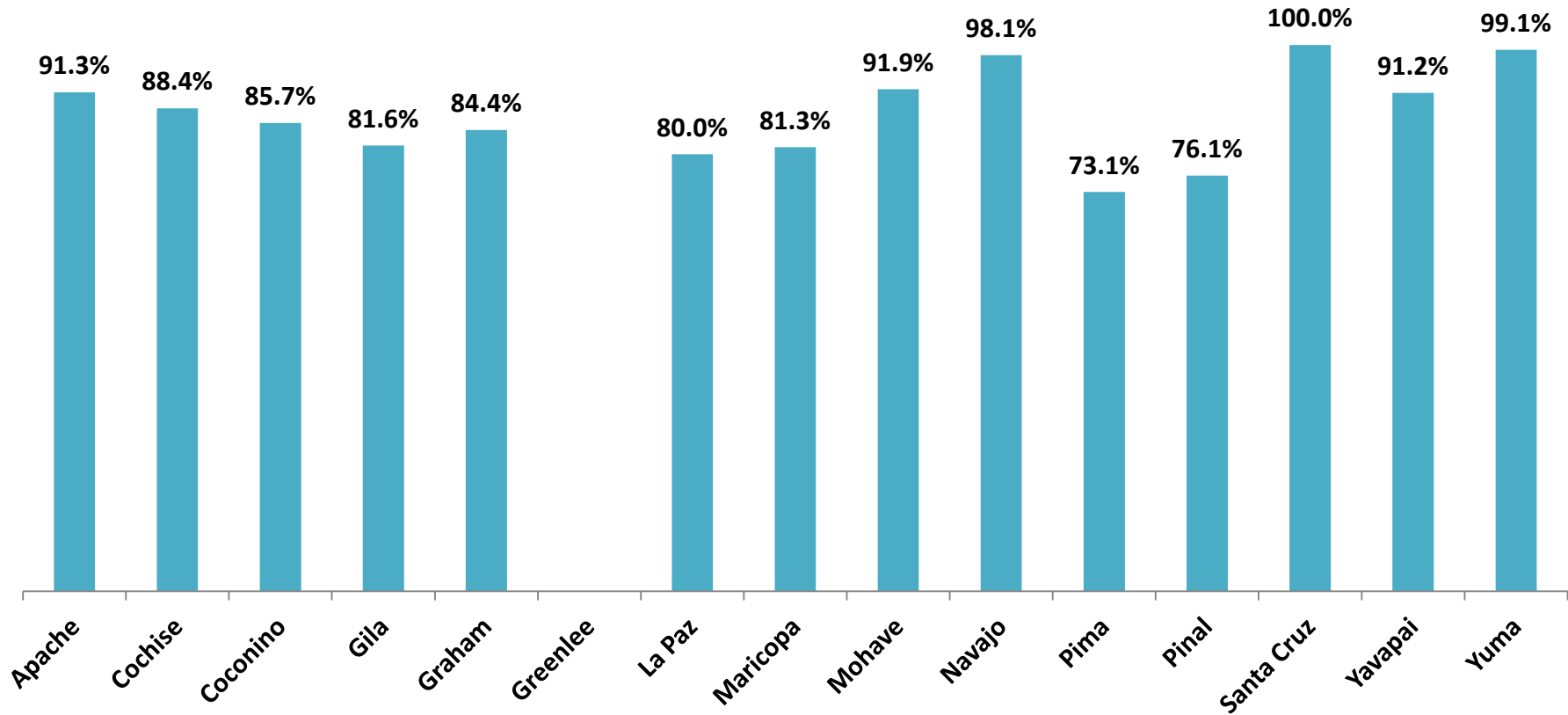
