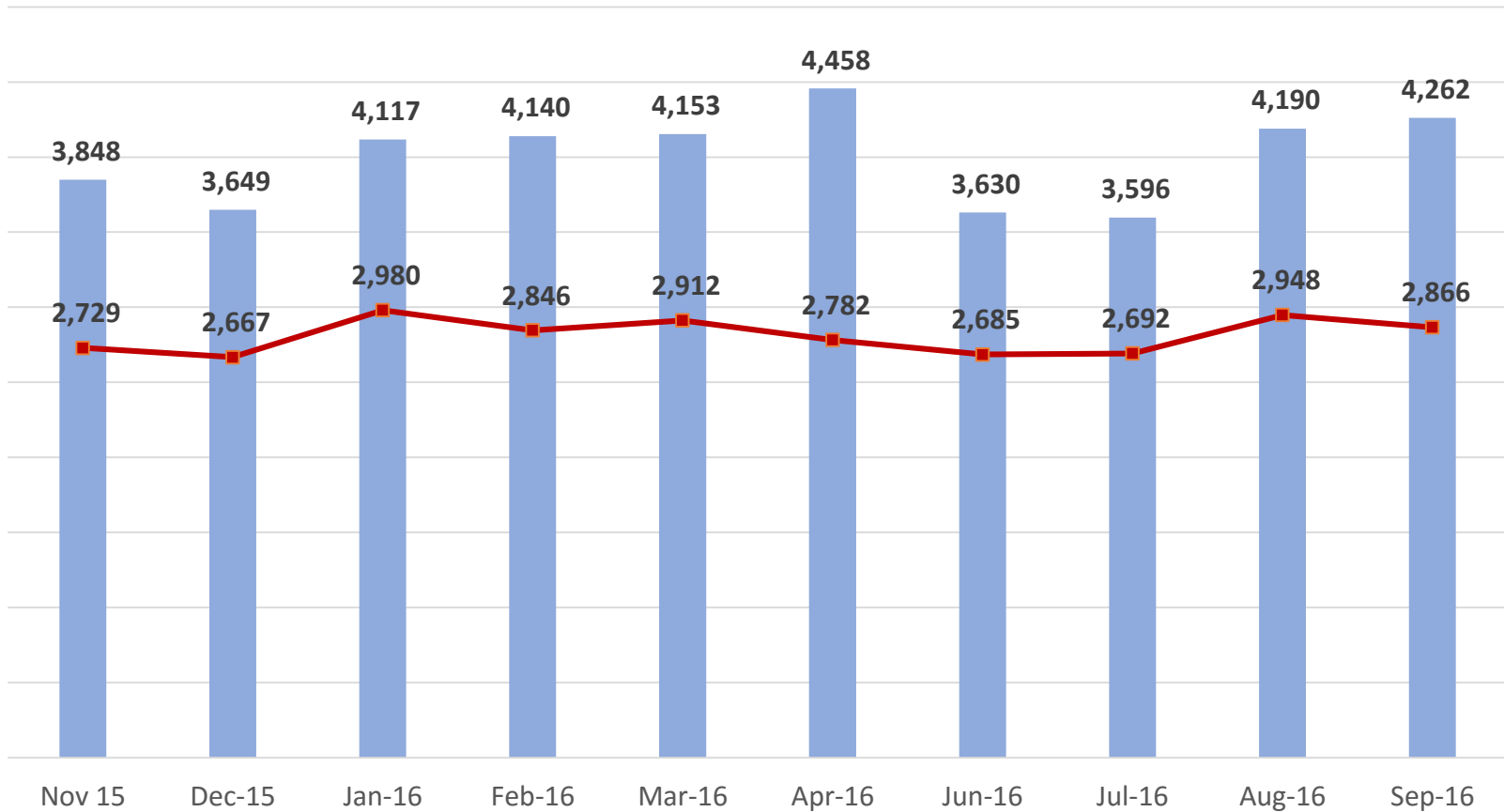

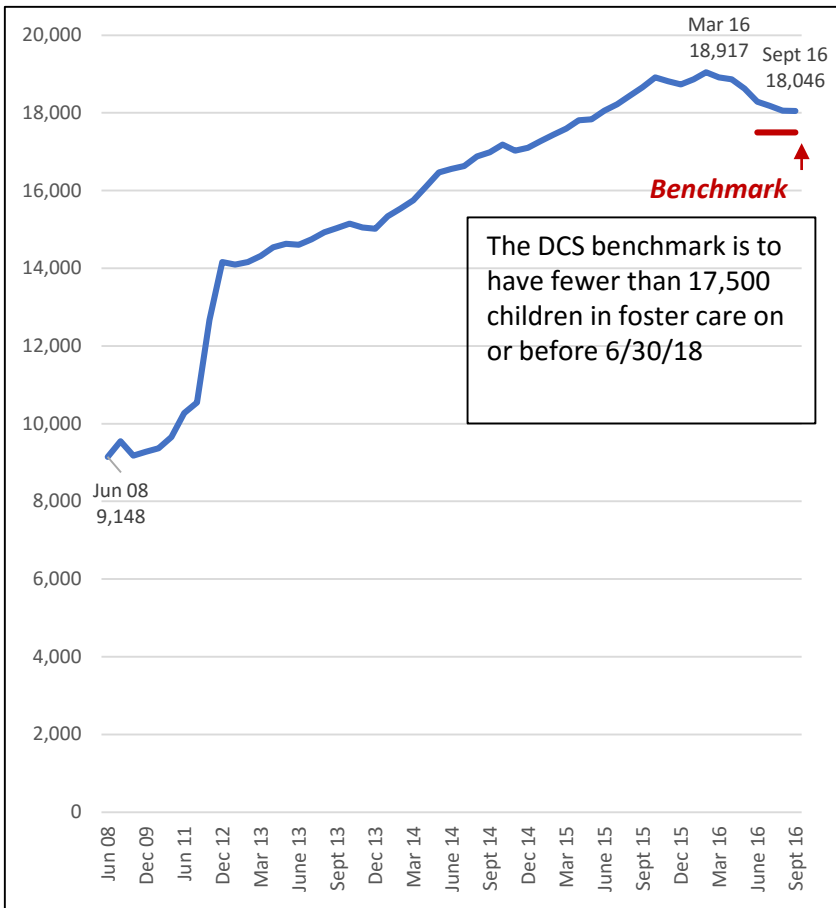

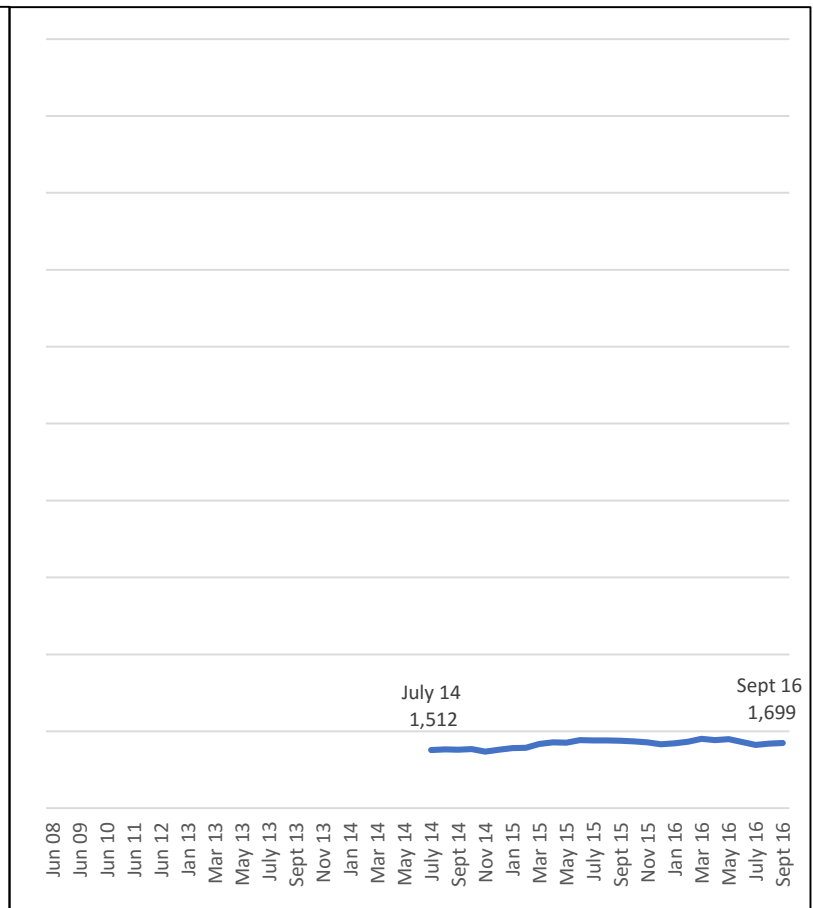

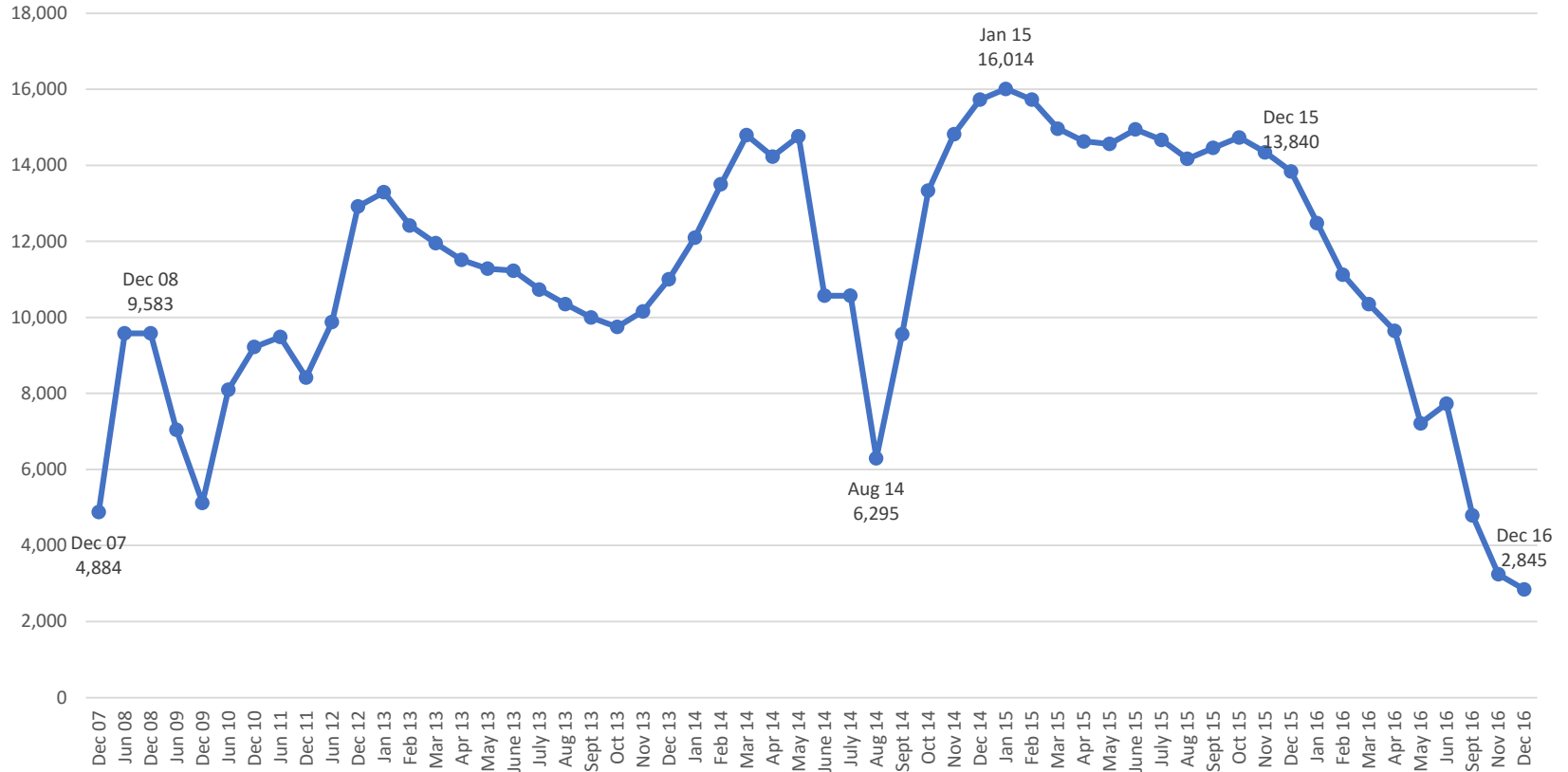

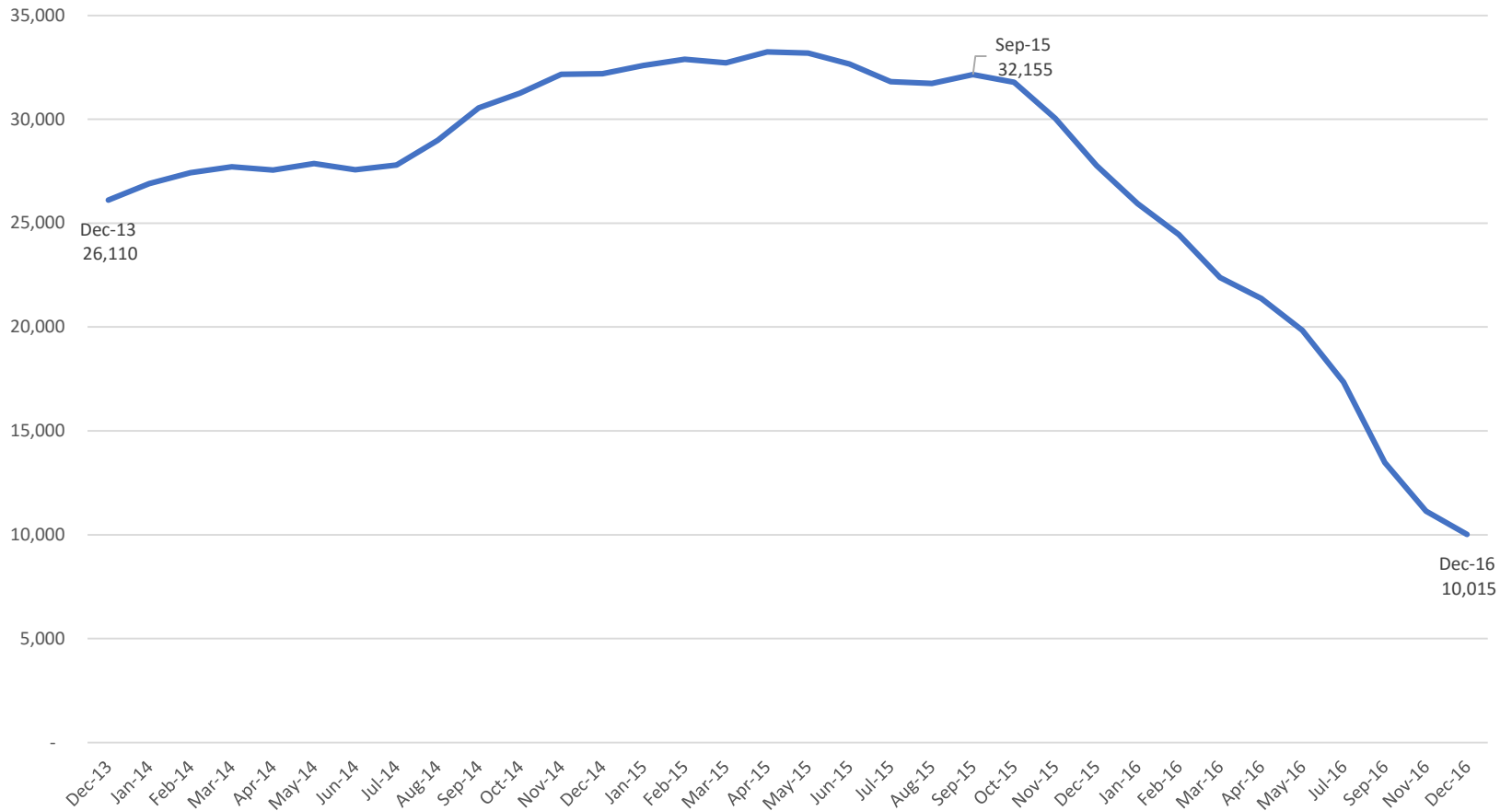

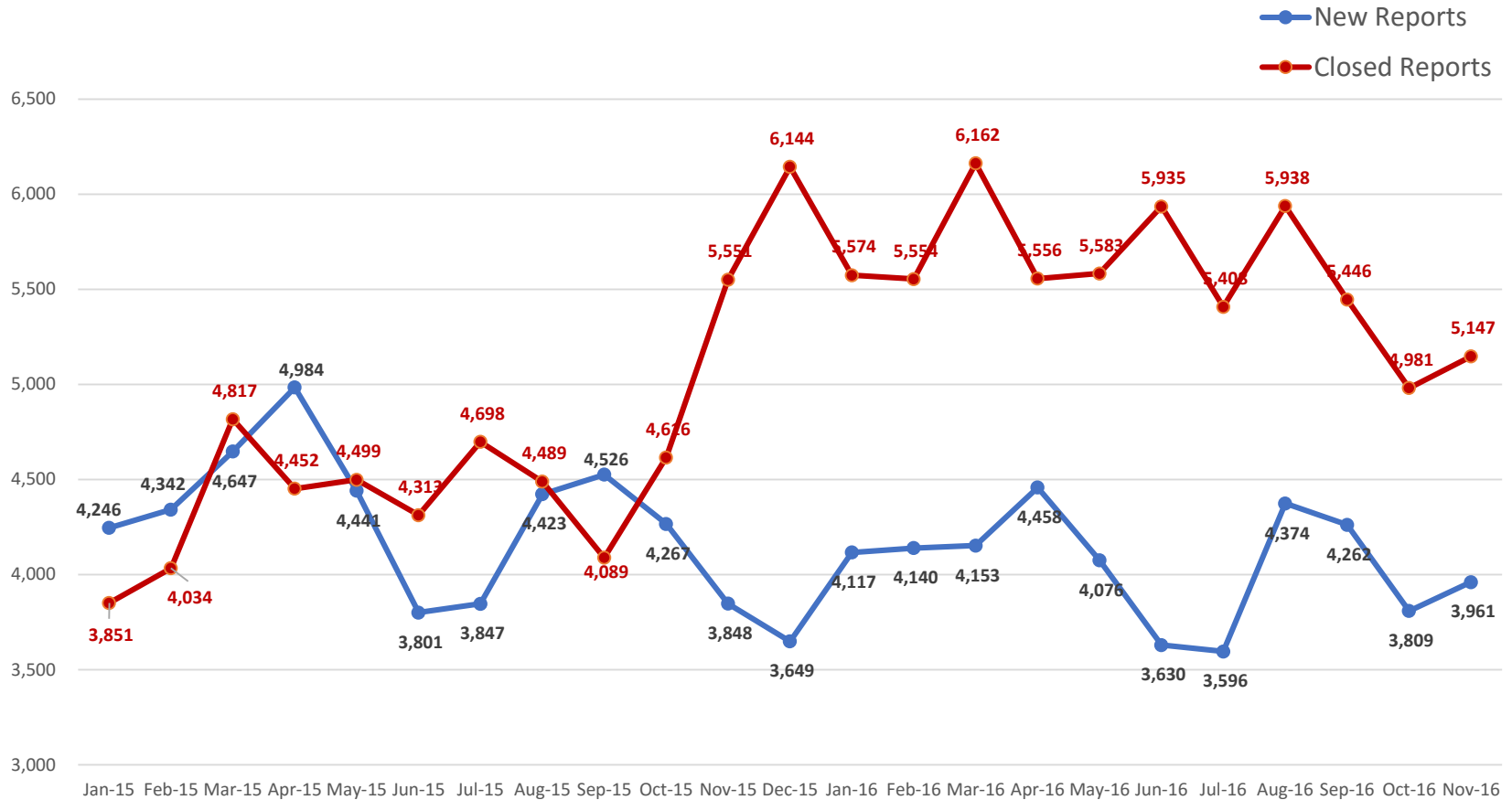

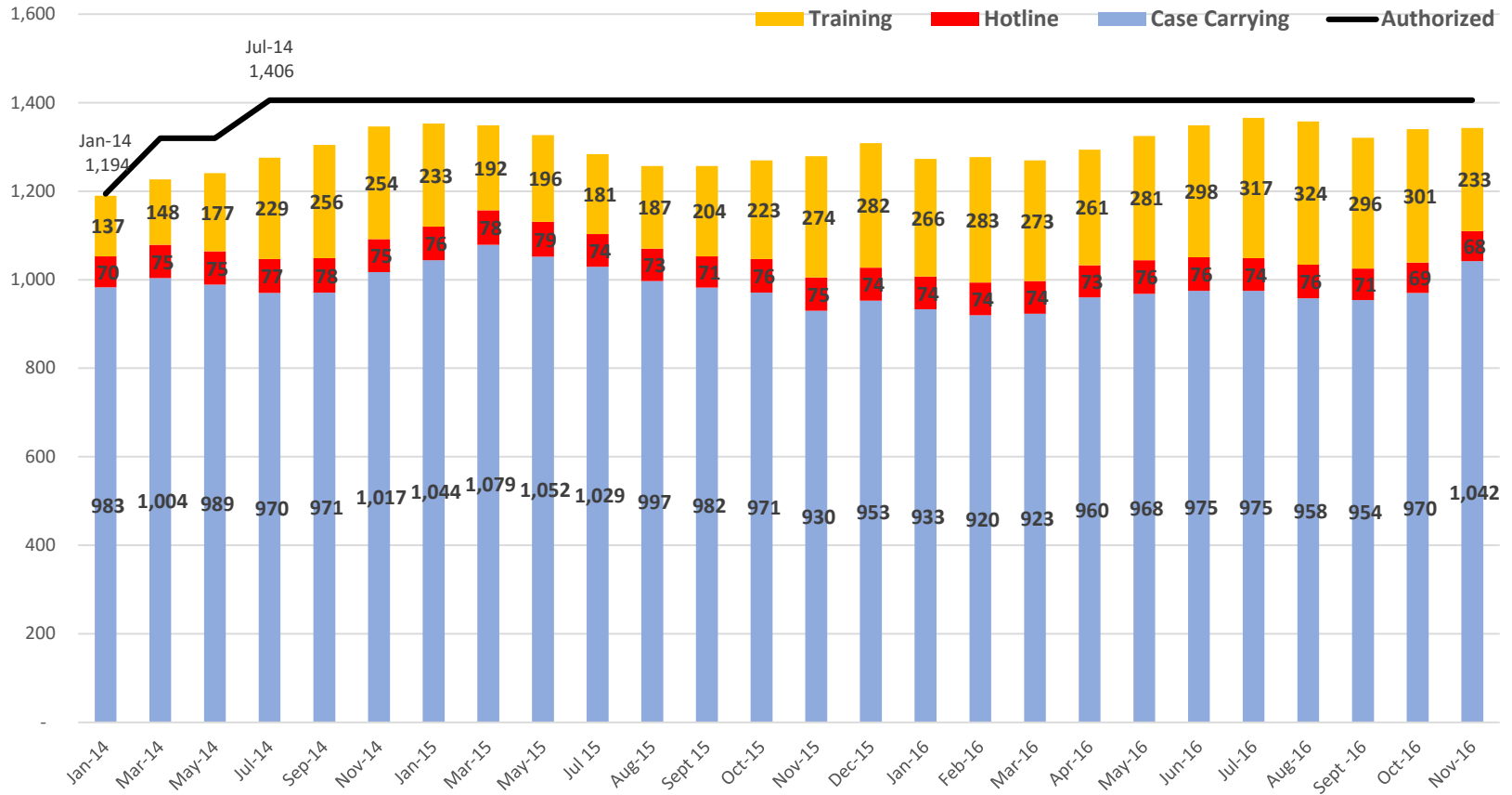

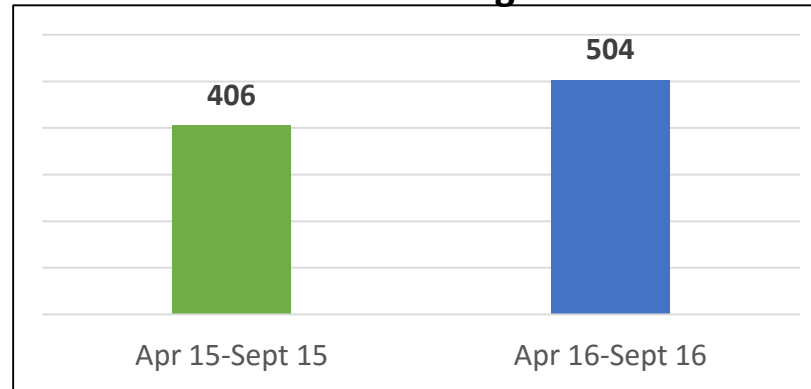

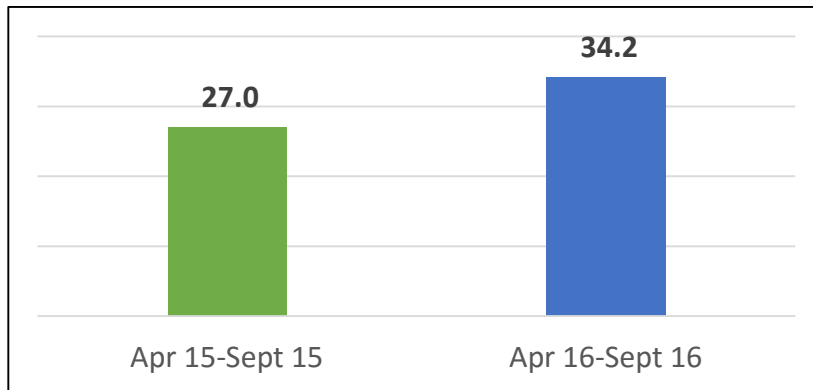


YOUNG ADULTS LEAVING FOSTER CARE BECAUSE THEY TURNED AGE 18

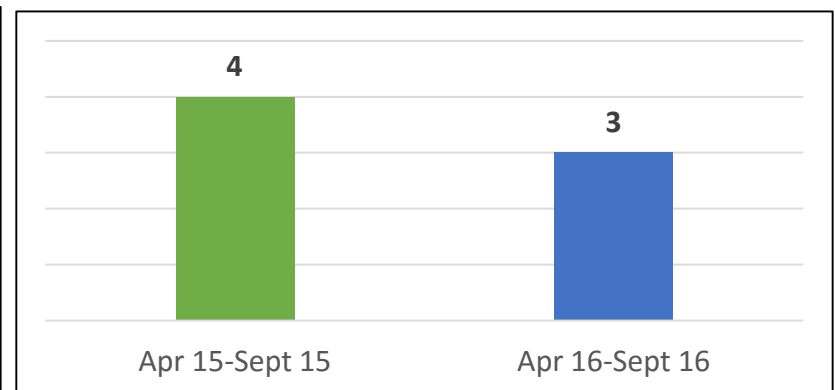
Number of Young Adults

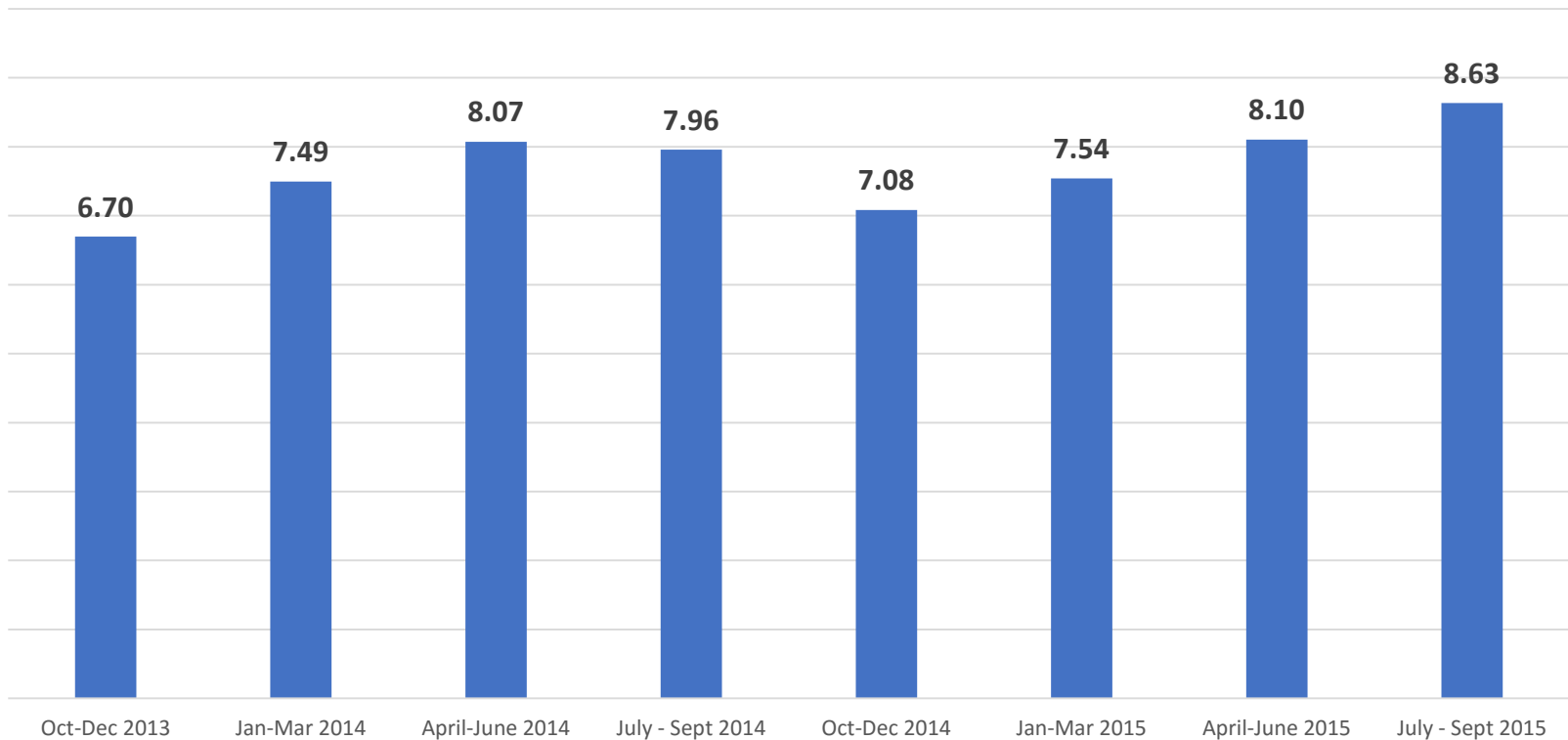

FOSTER CARE ENTRY RATE PER 1,000 CHILD POPULATION

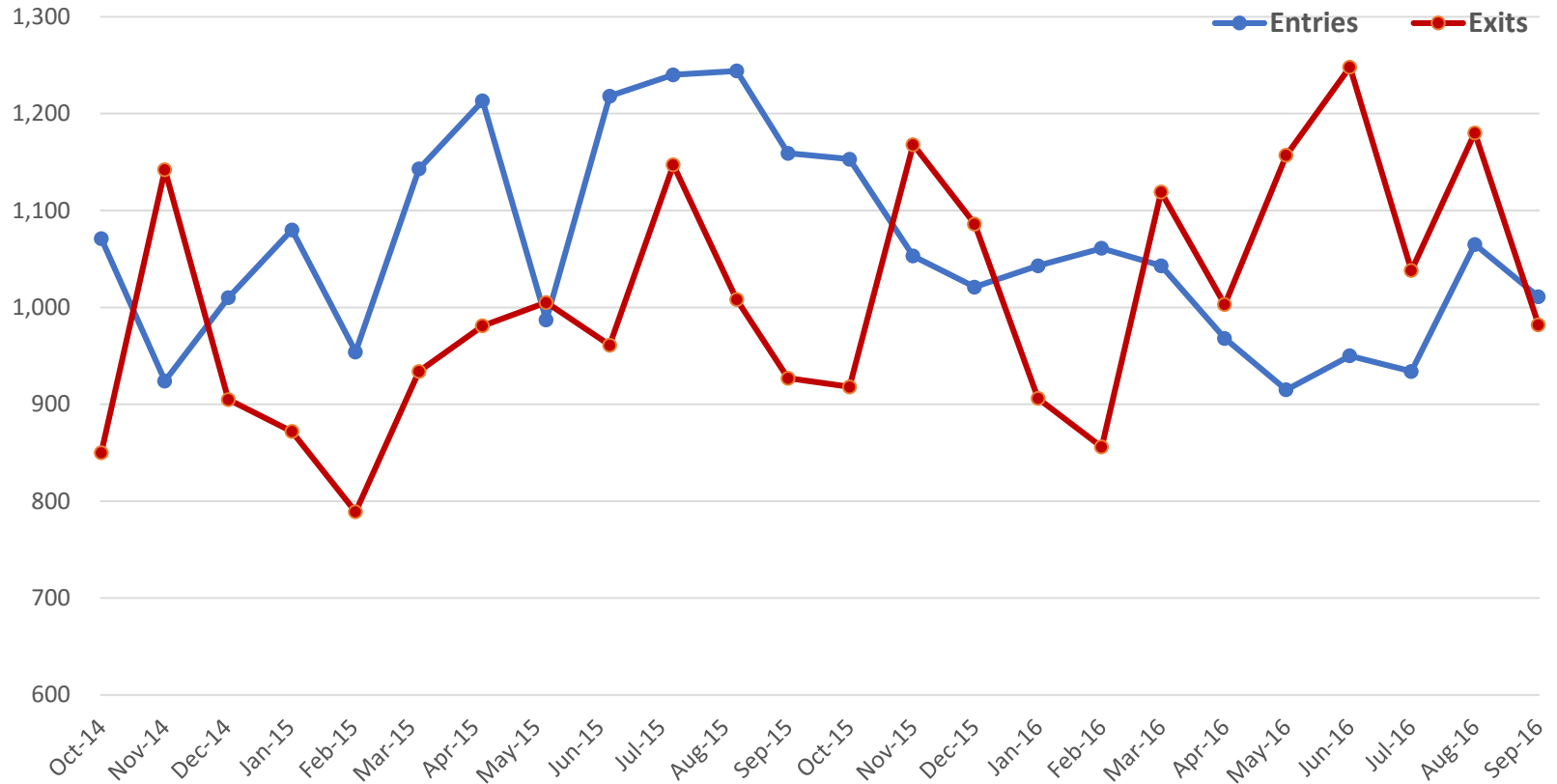

CHILDREN ENTERING FOSTER CARE COMPARED TO CHILDREN EXITING FOSTER CARE

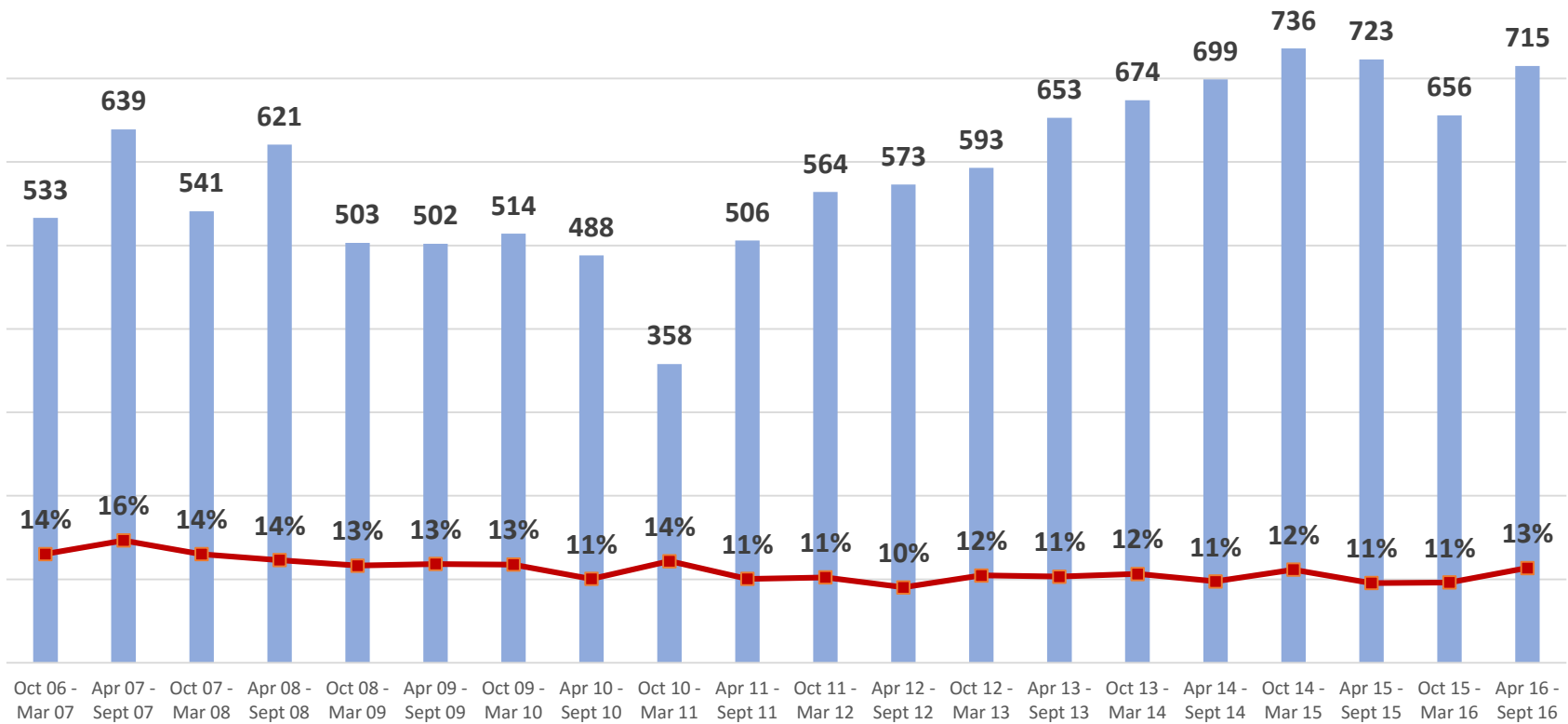

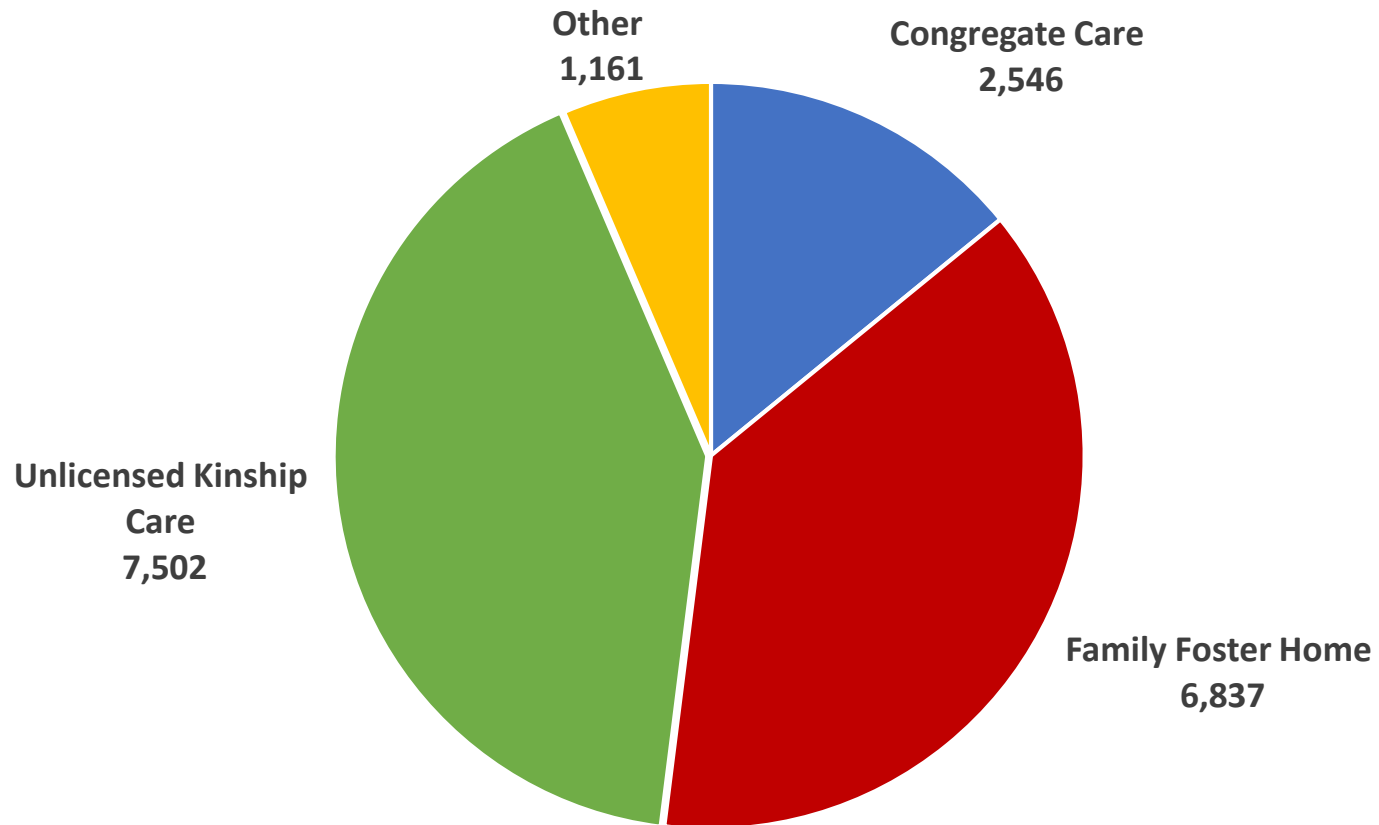

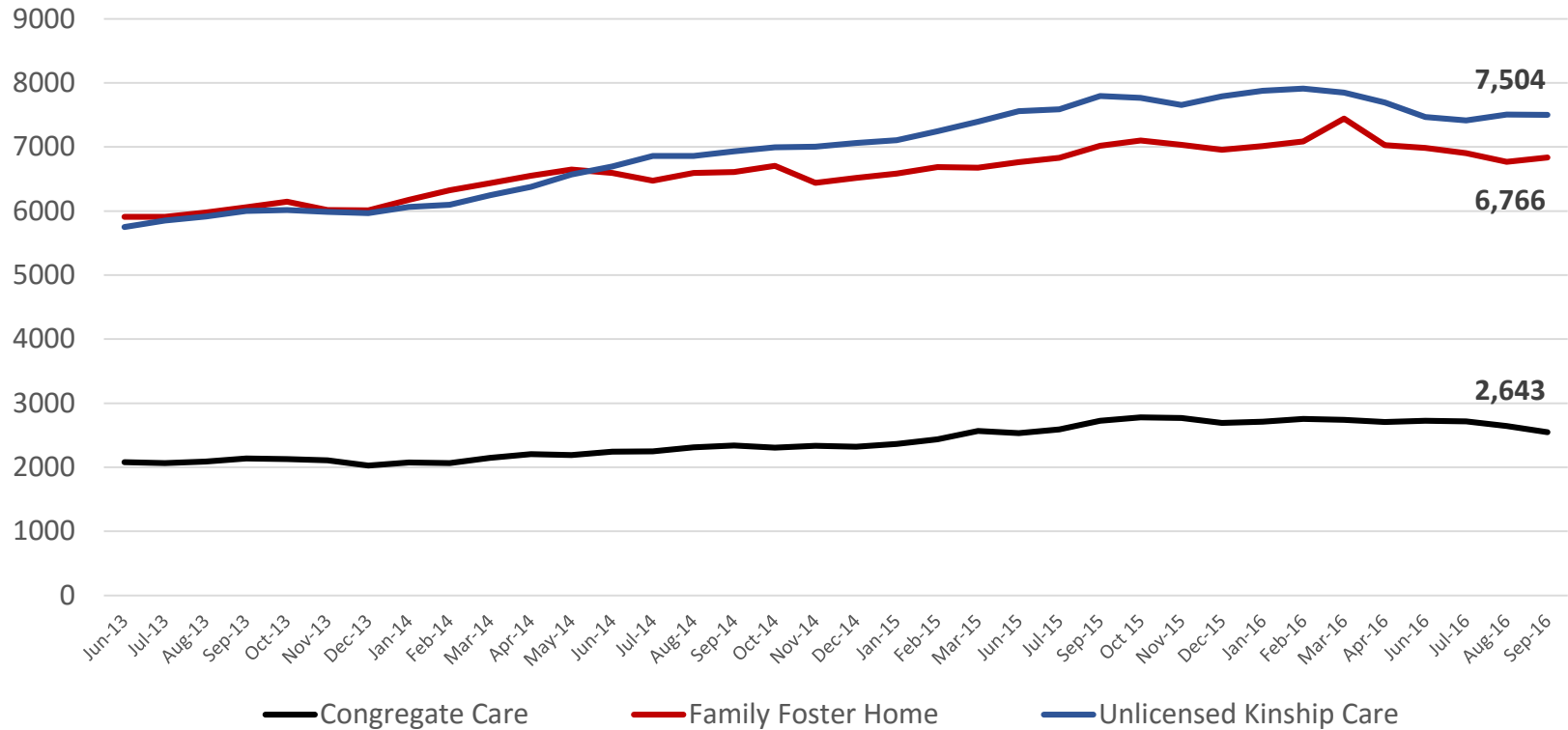

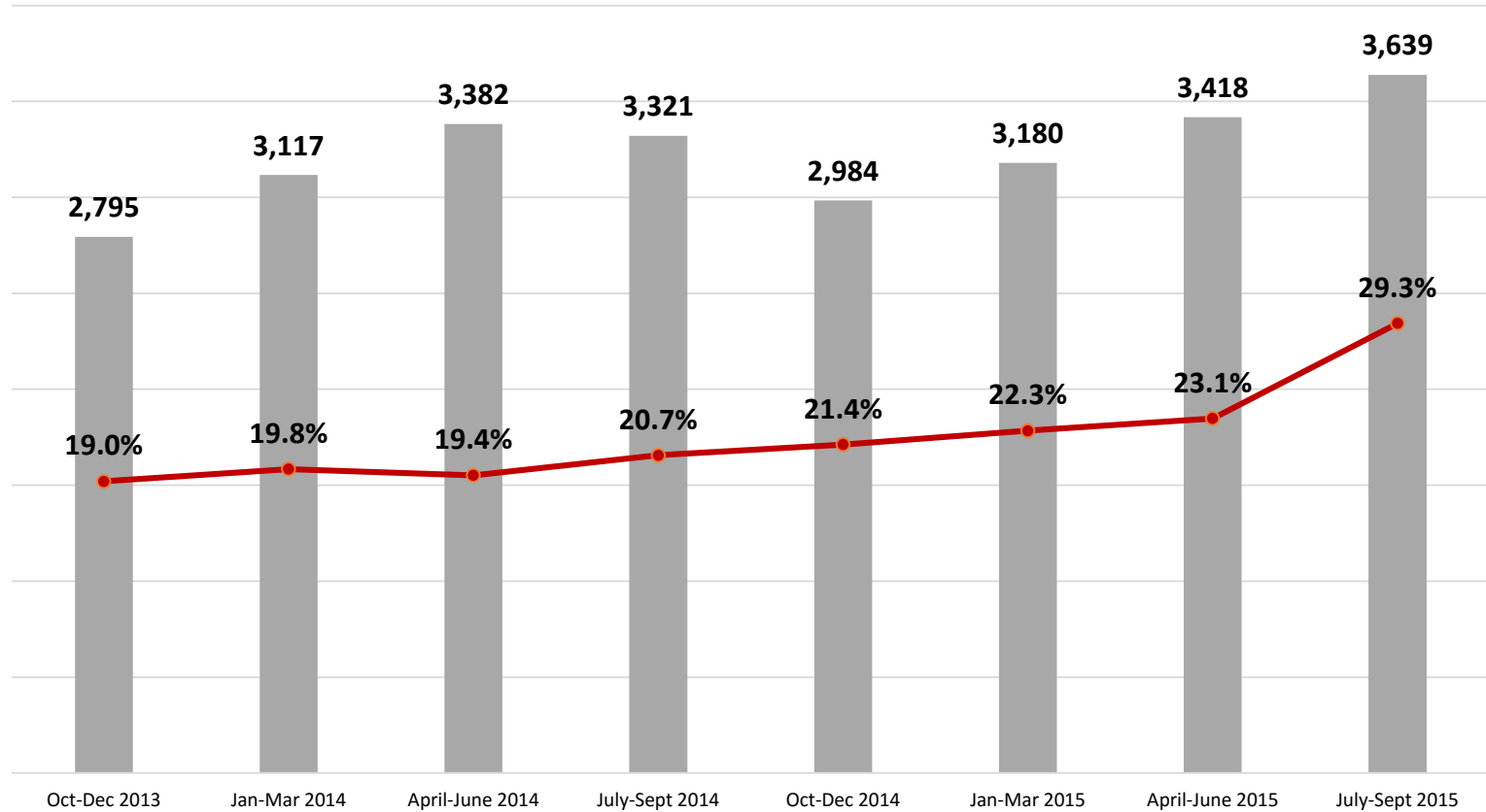

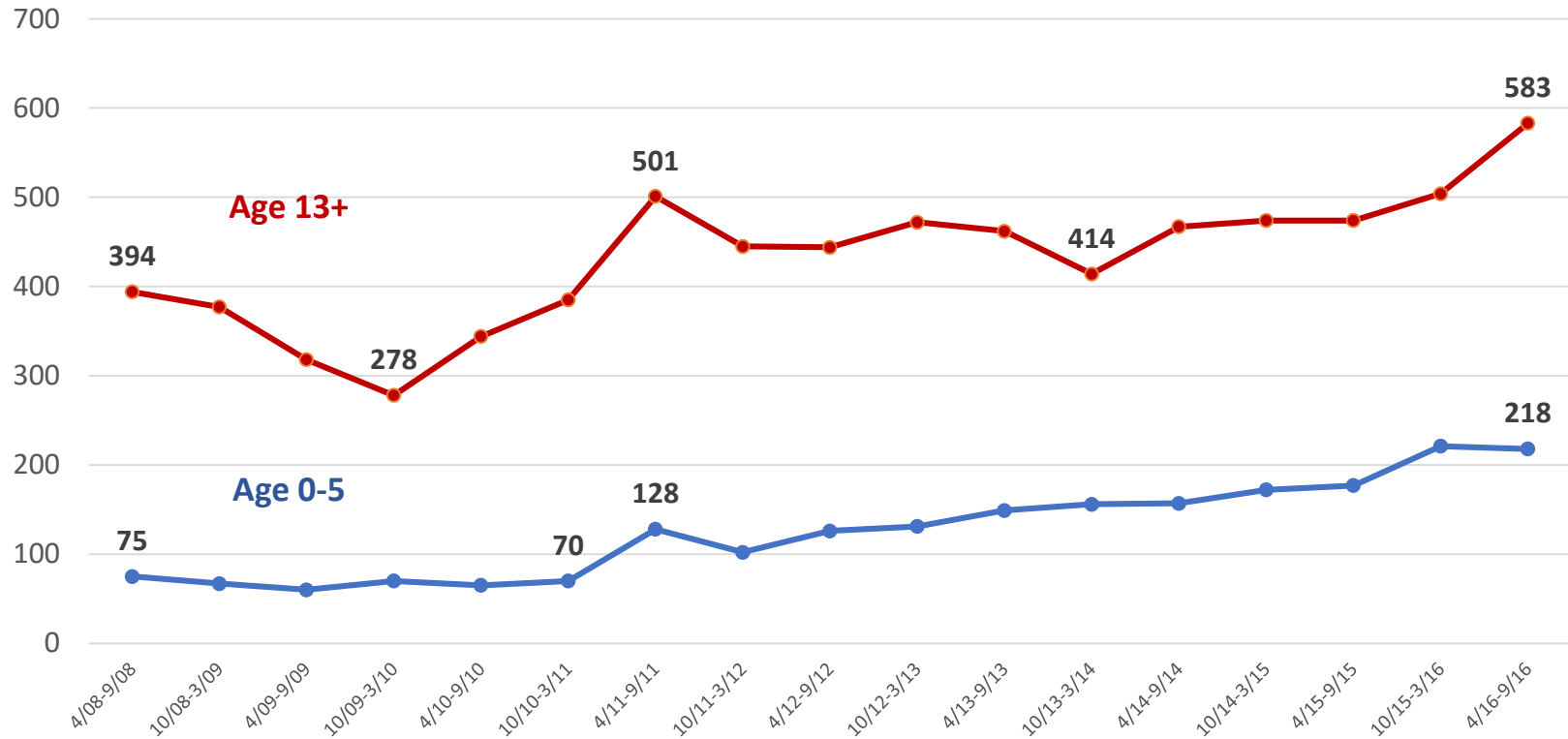
