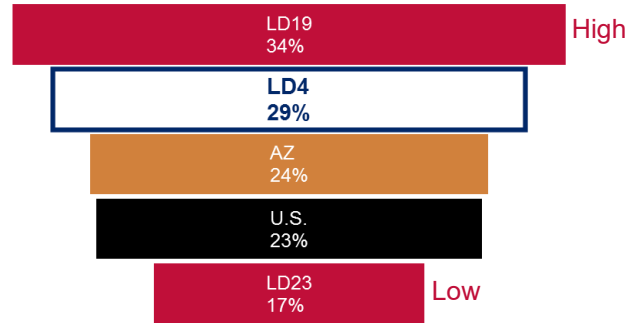

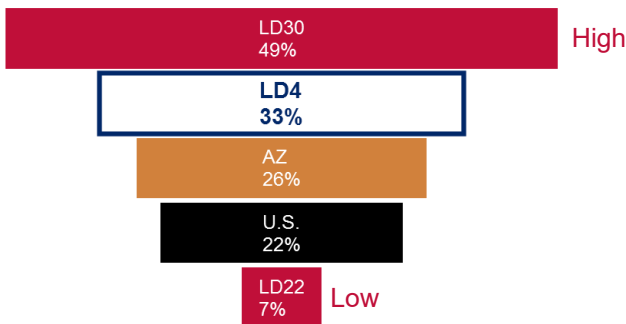

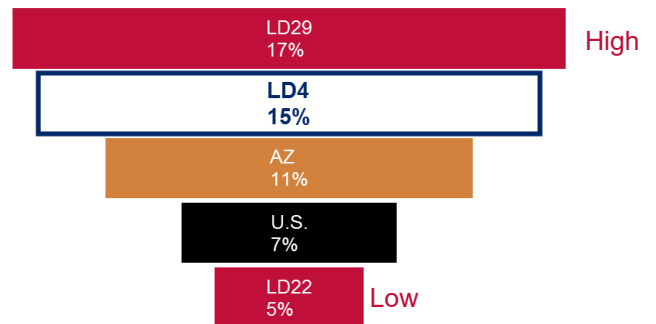
Total Population Who are Children



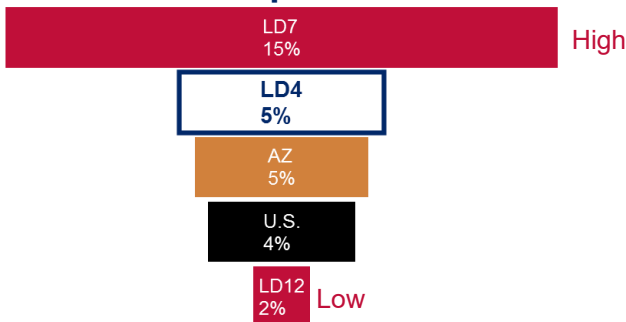
Children Living in Poverty



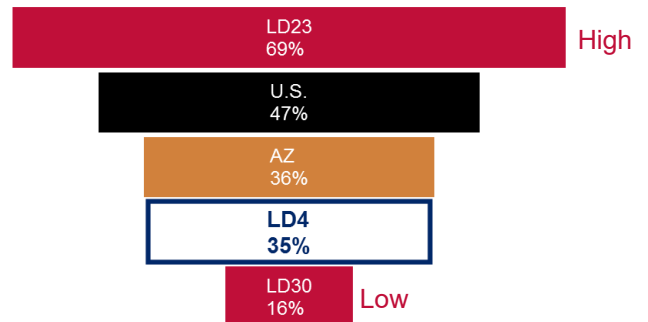
Children Without Health Insurance

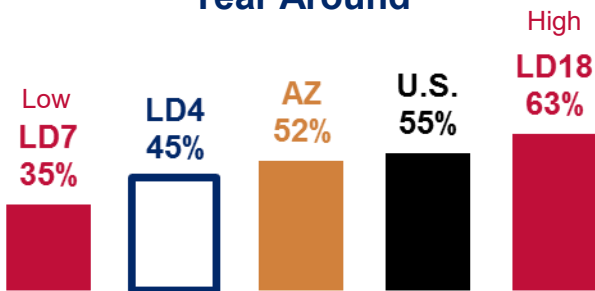

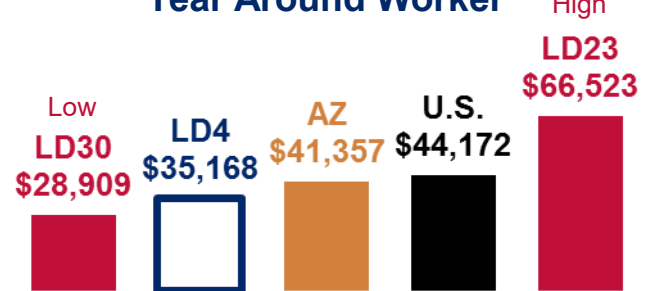

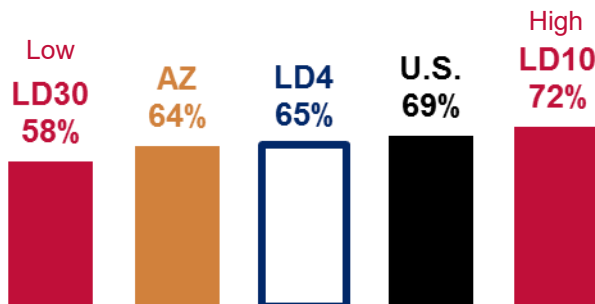
25-64 Year Olds Working Full Time, Year Around



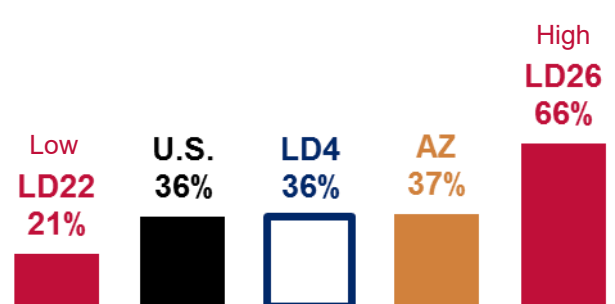
Median Earnings Per Full Time, Year Around Worker



Children in Families Where All Parents are in the Labor Force



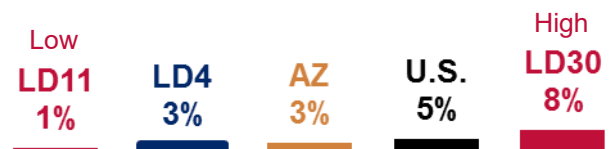
Percent of Housing that is Rented



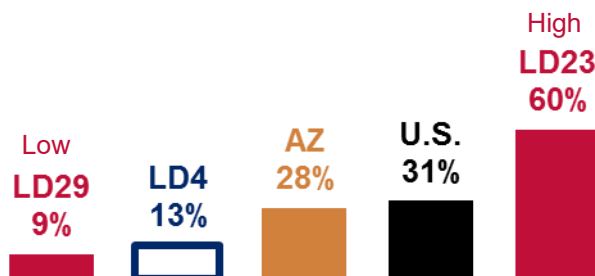
Moved to Arizona Last Year
