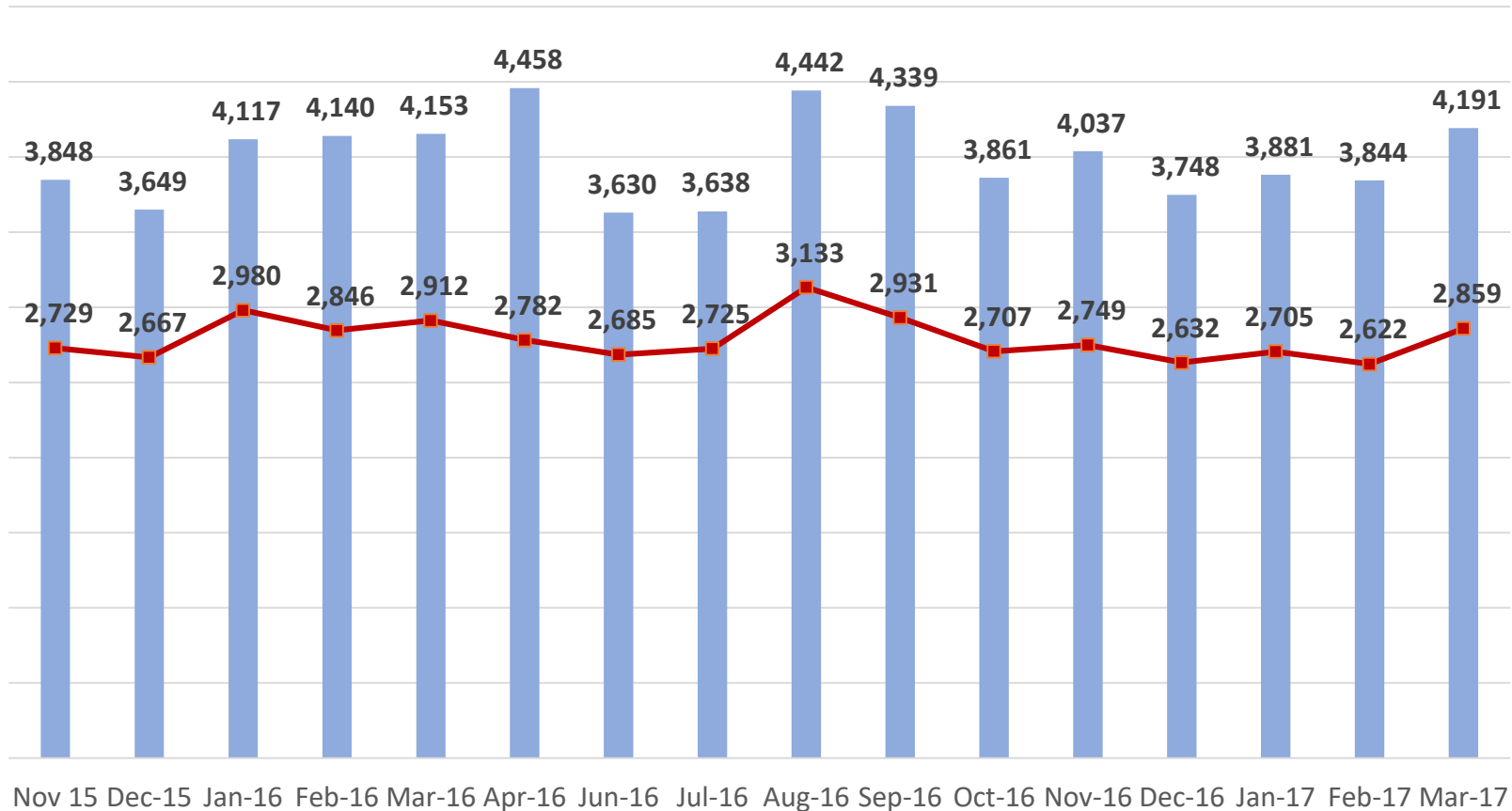

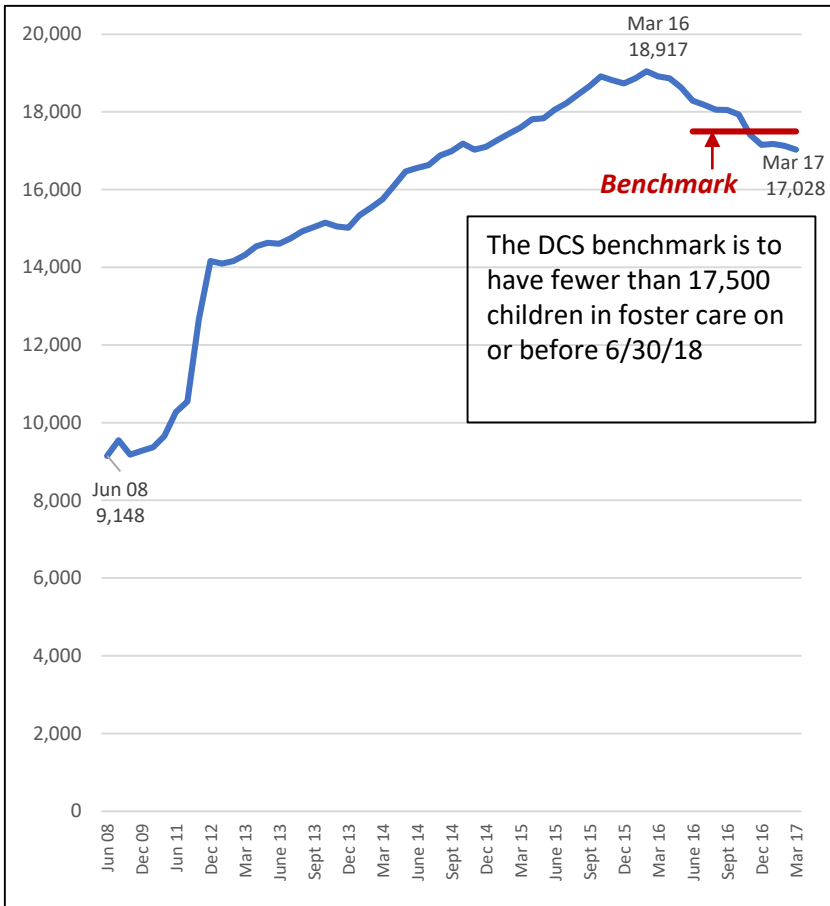

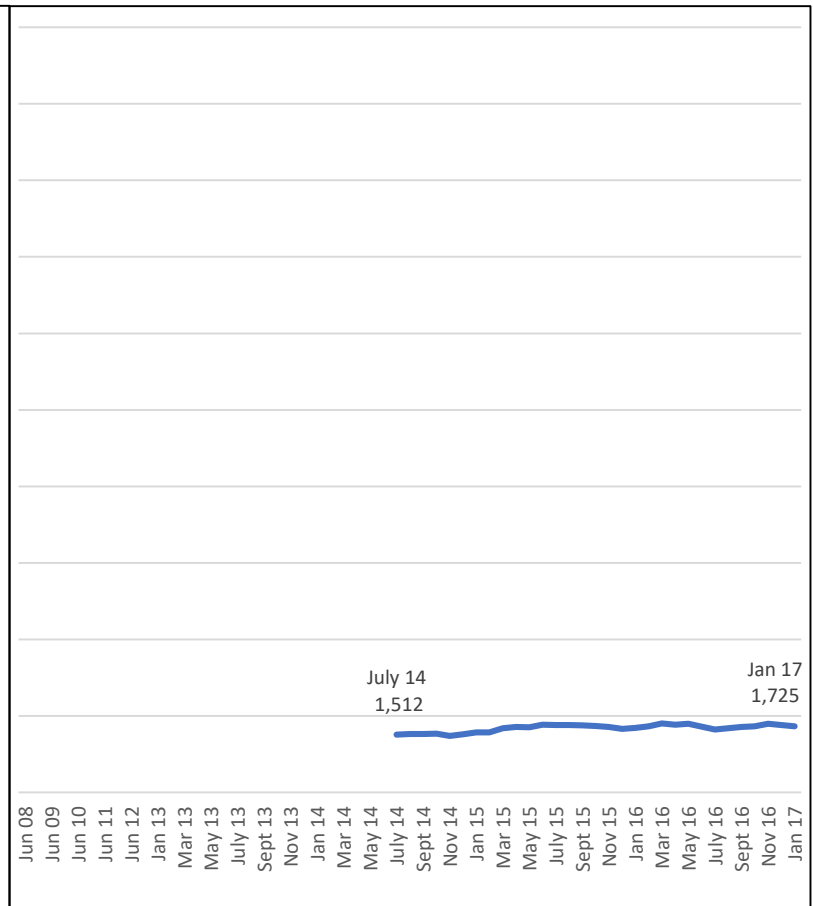

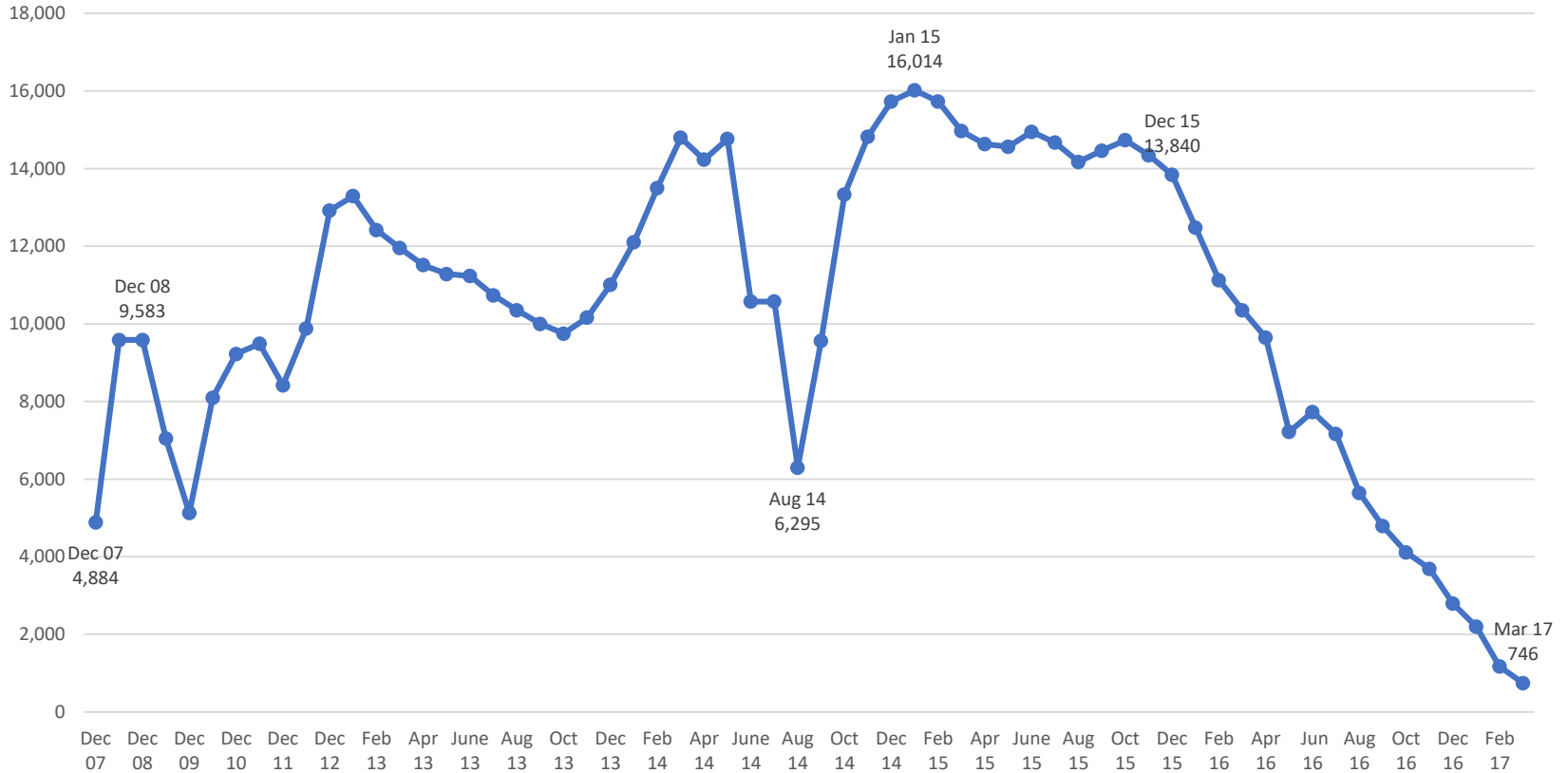

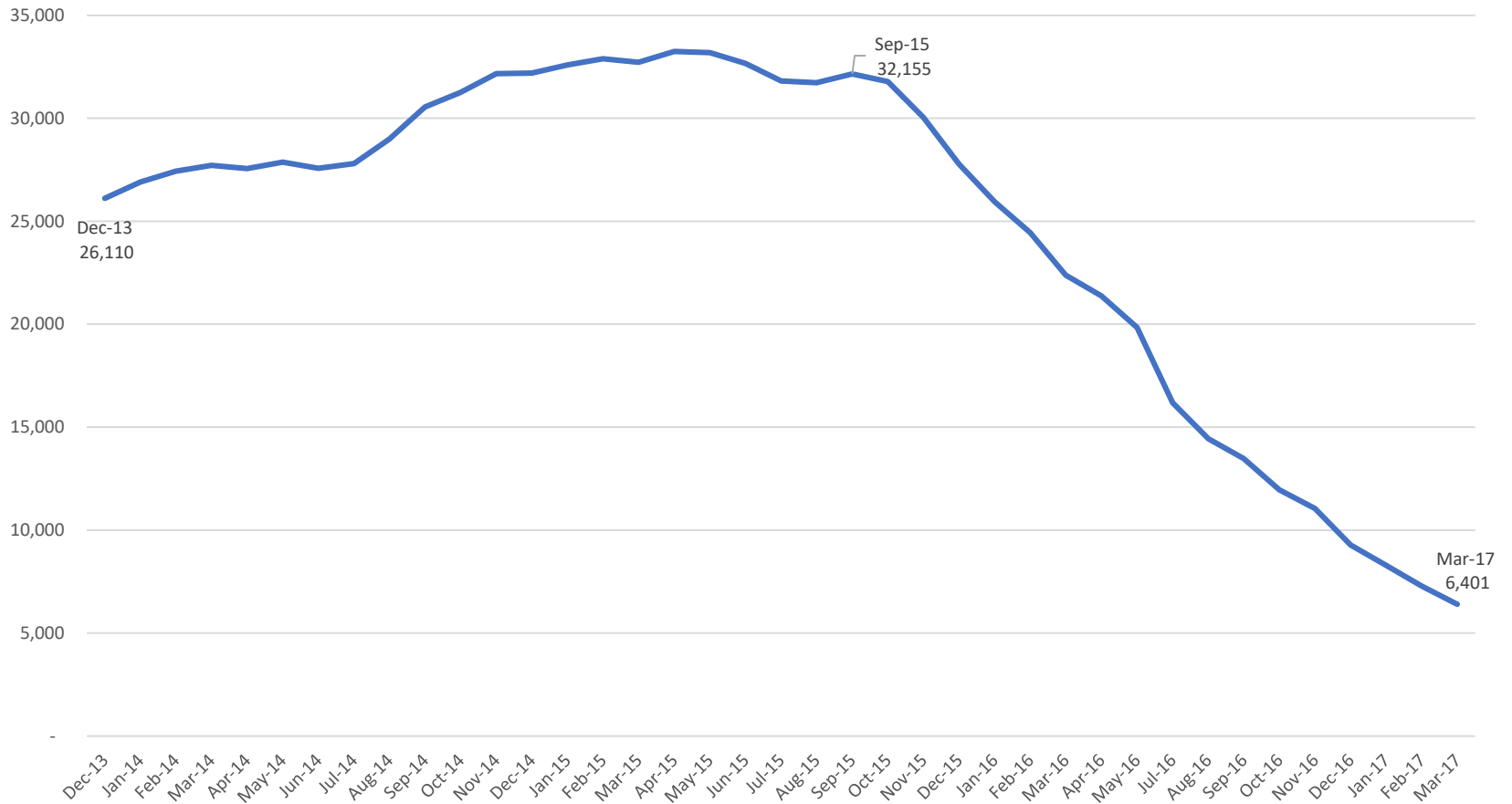

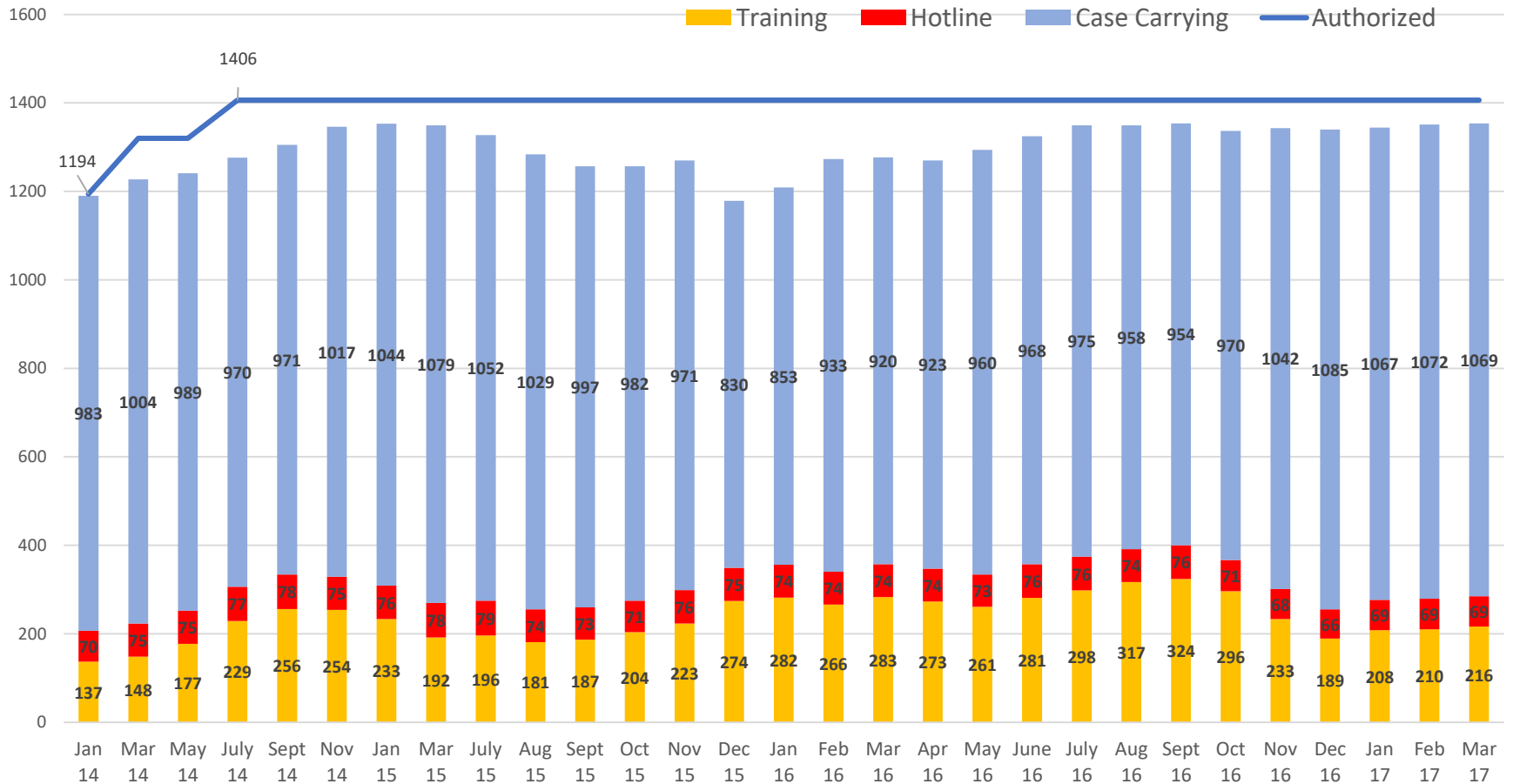

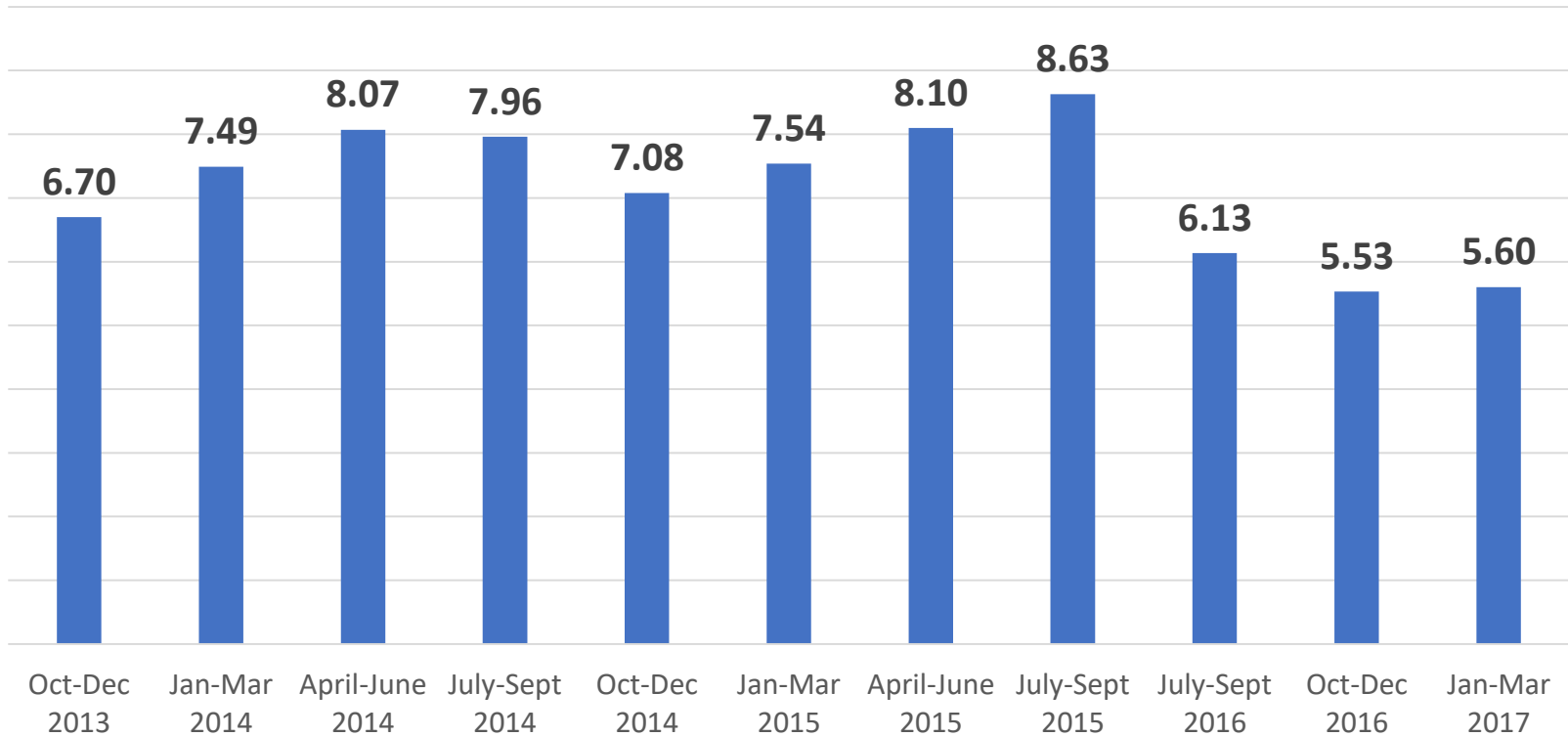

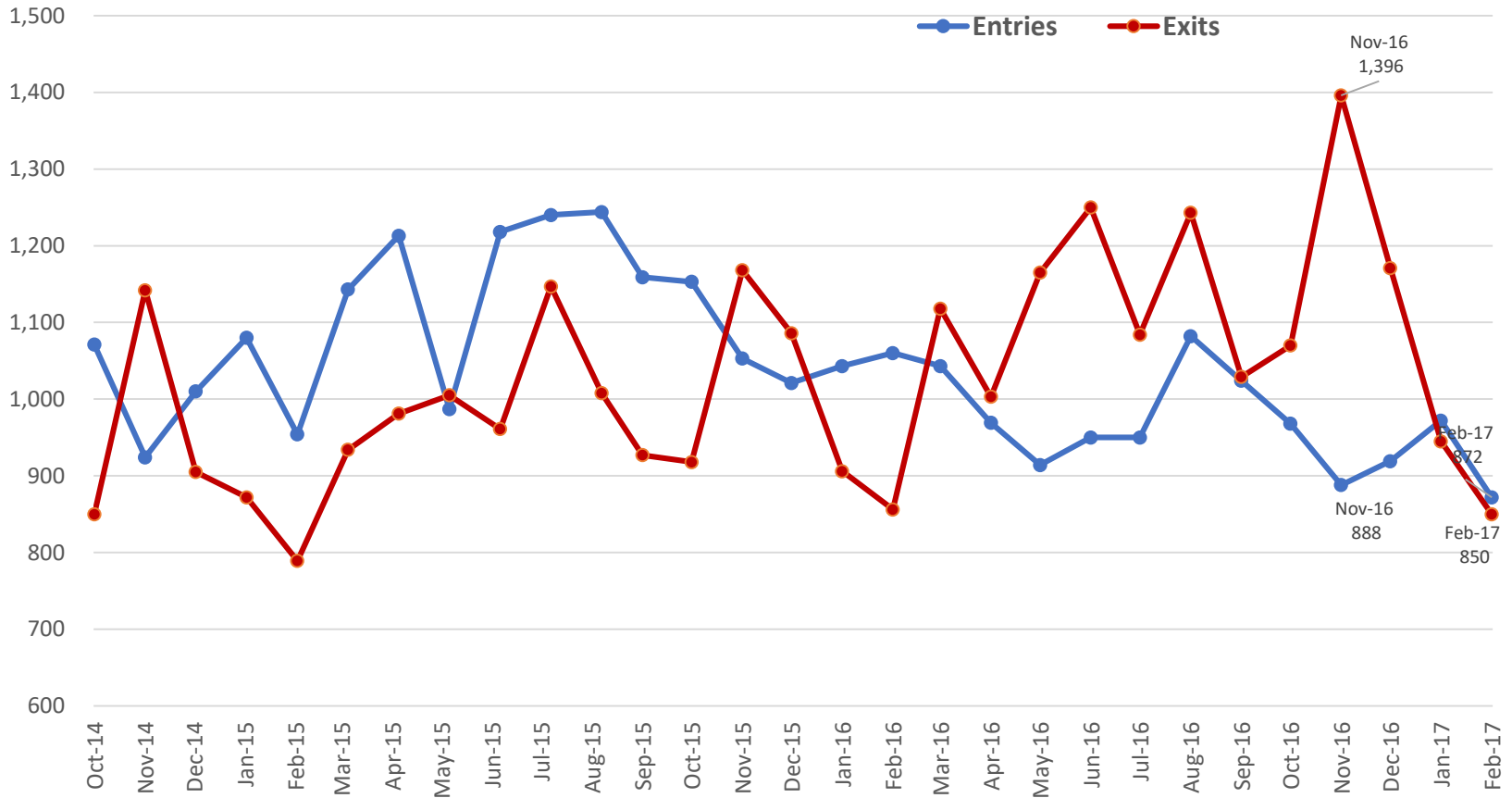
FOSTER CARE ENTRY RATE PER 1,000 CHILD POPULATION

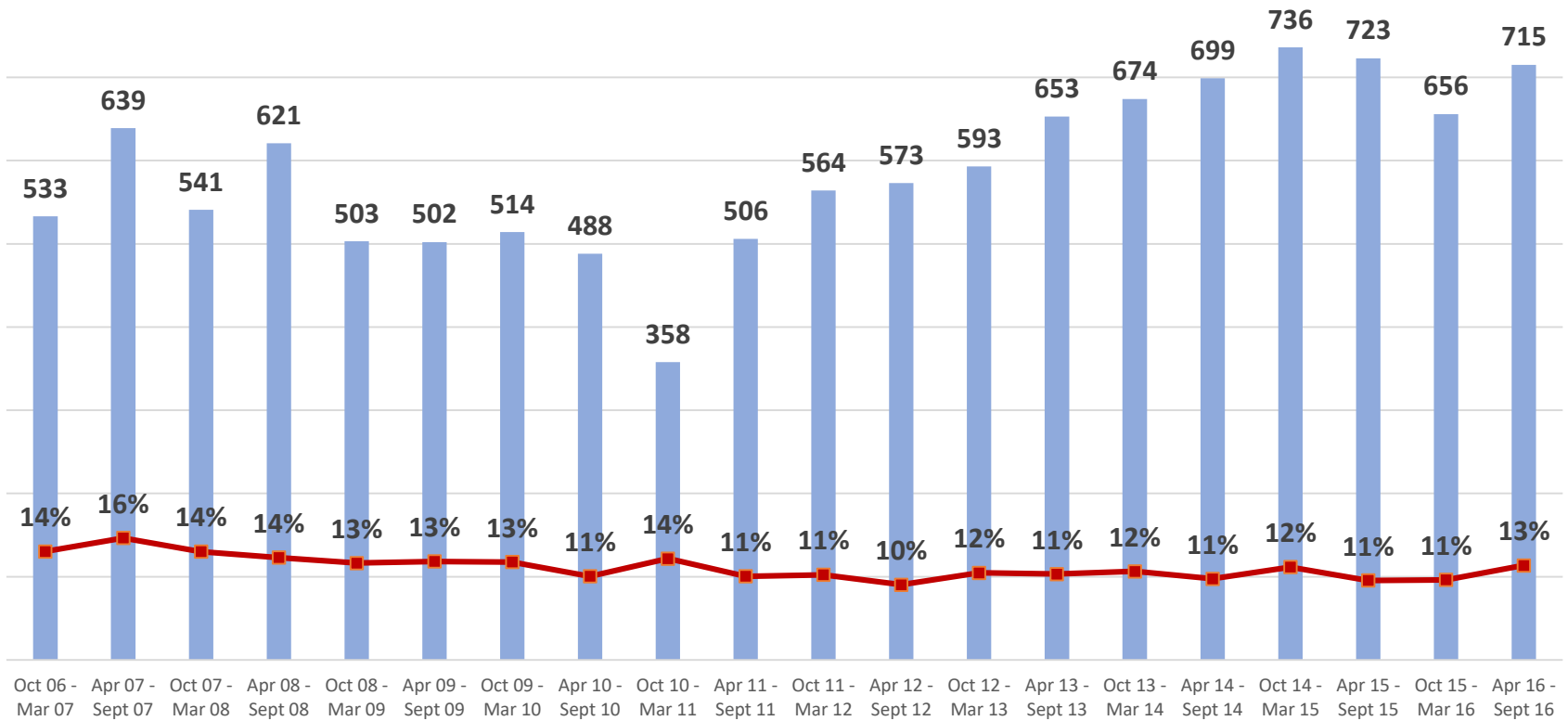
CHILDREN ENTERING FOSTER CARE COMPARED TO CHILDREN EXITING FOSTER CARE

KIDS ENTERING FOSTER CARE WITH A PREVIOUS REMOVAL IN THE LAST 24 MONTHS

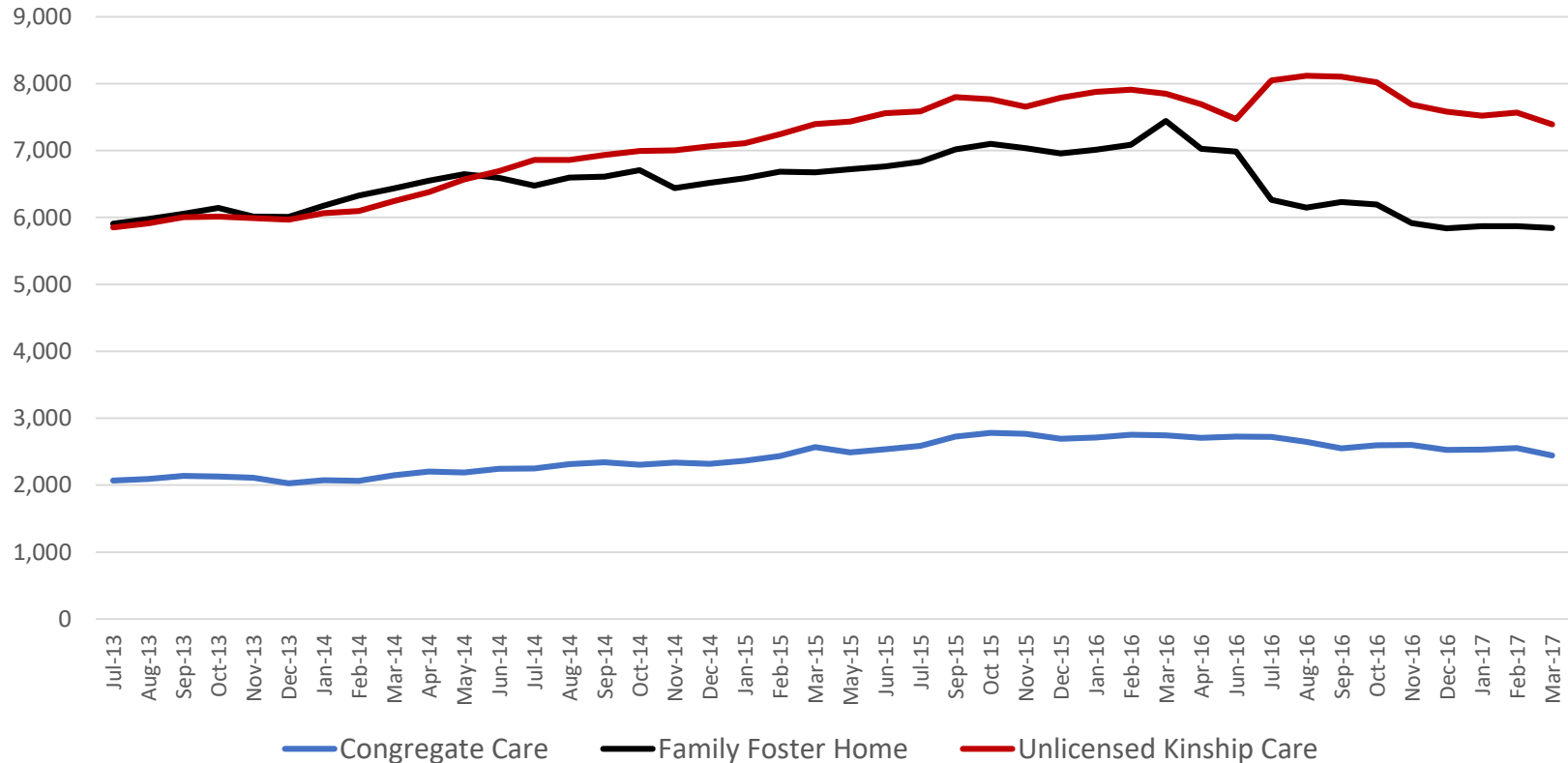

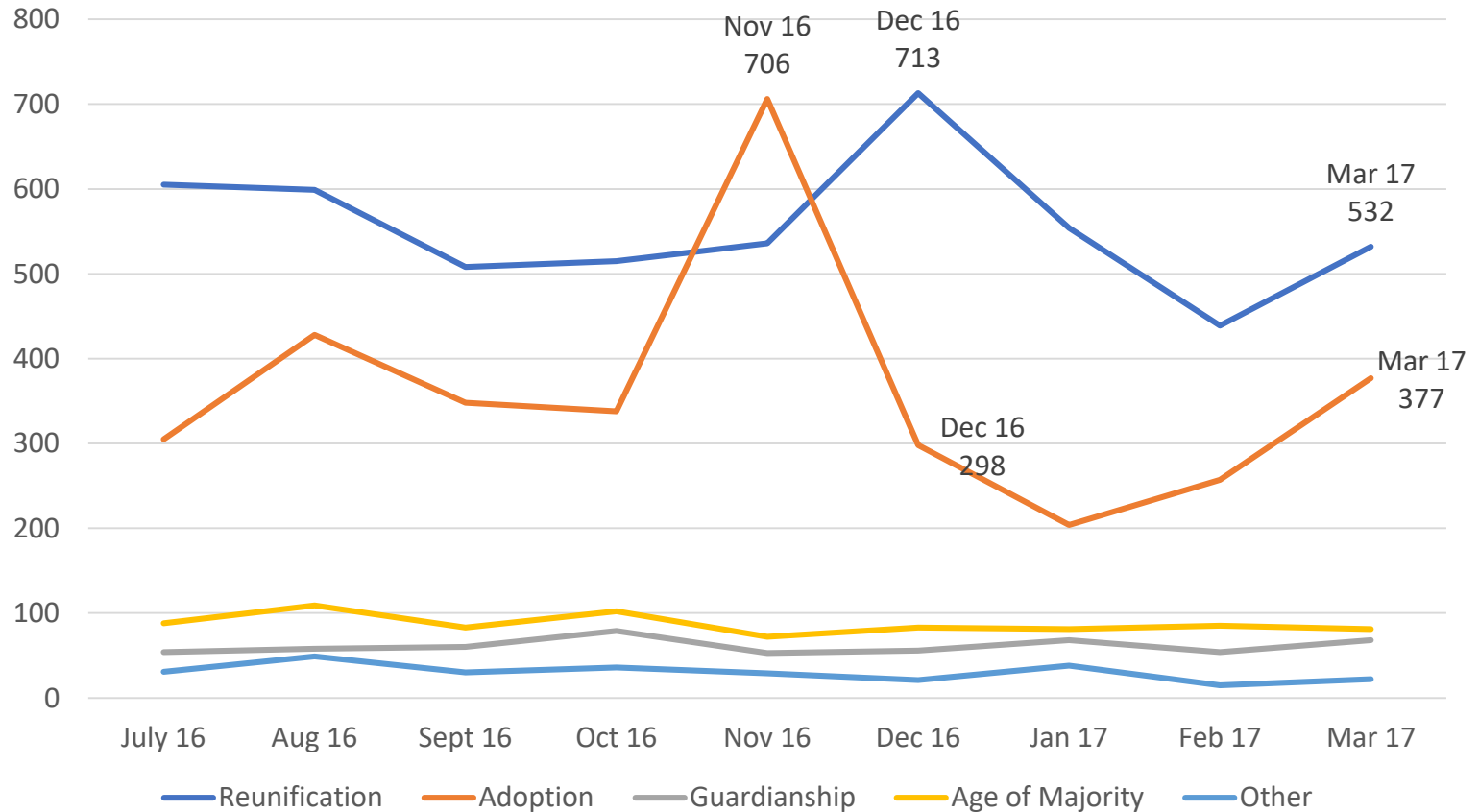

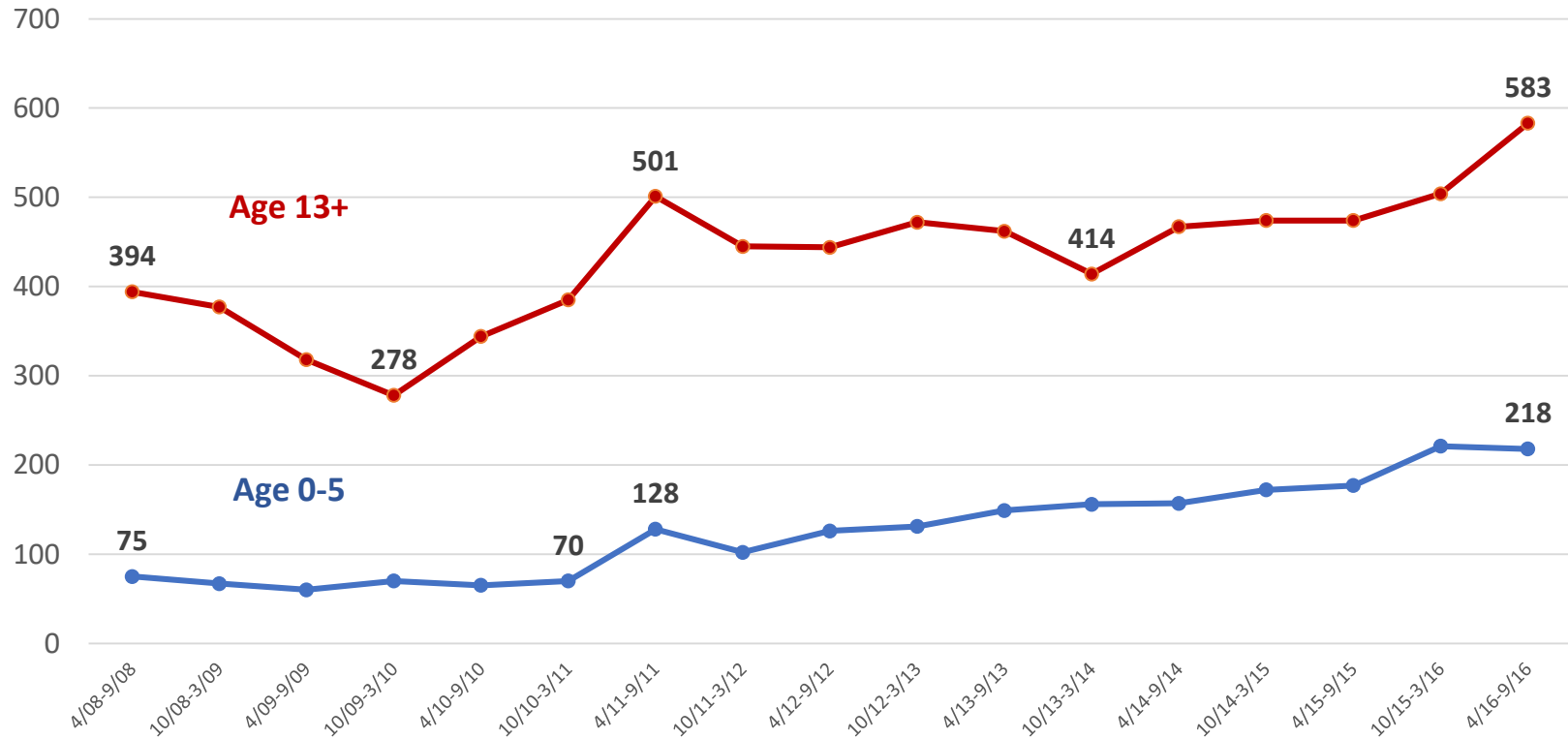
