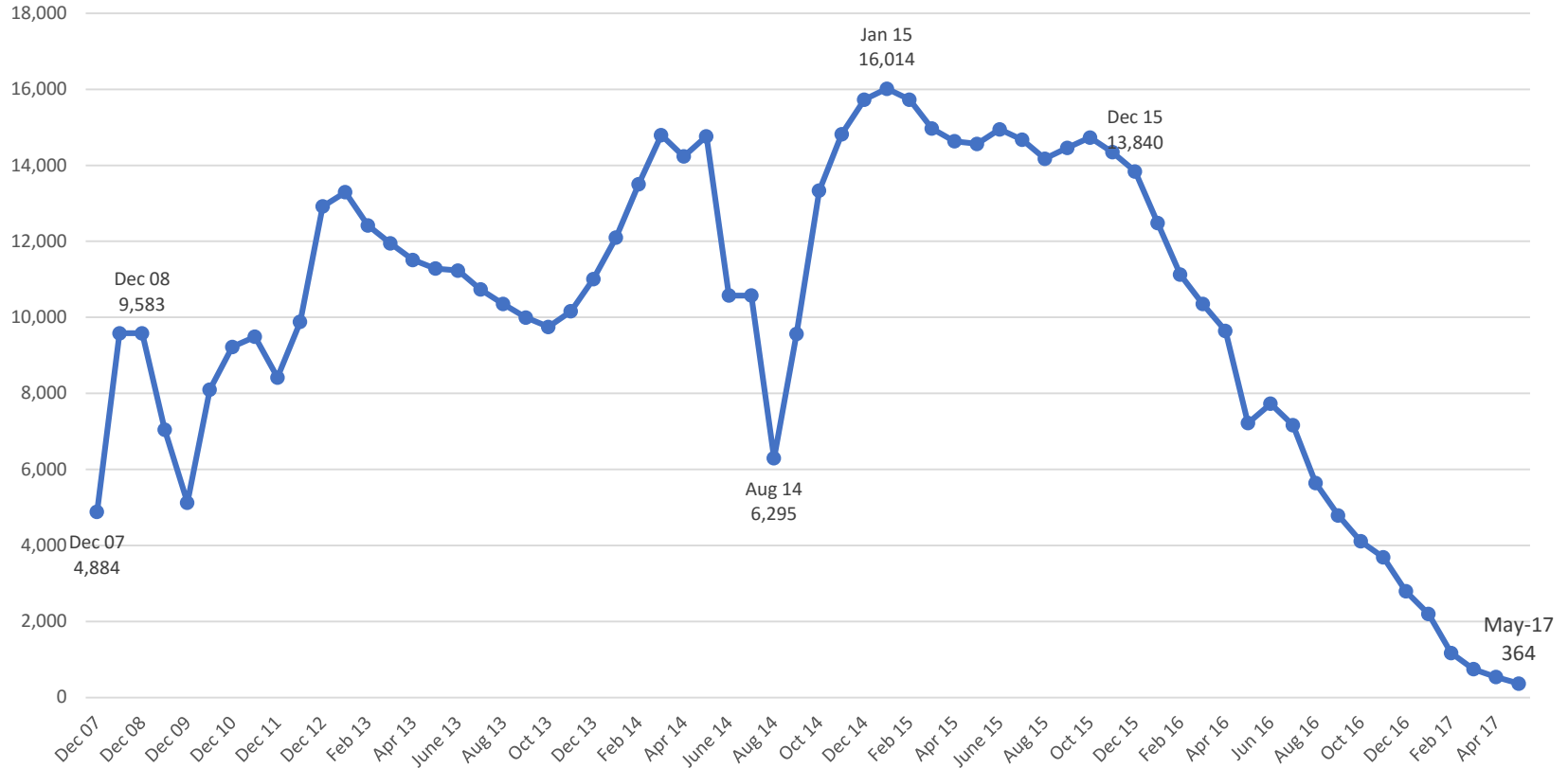

## TOTAL NON-ACTIVE CASES

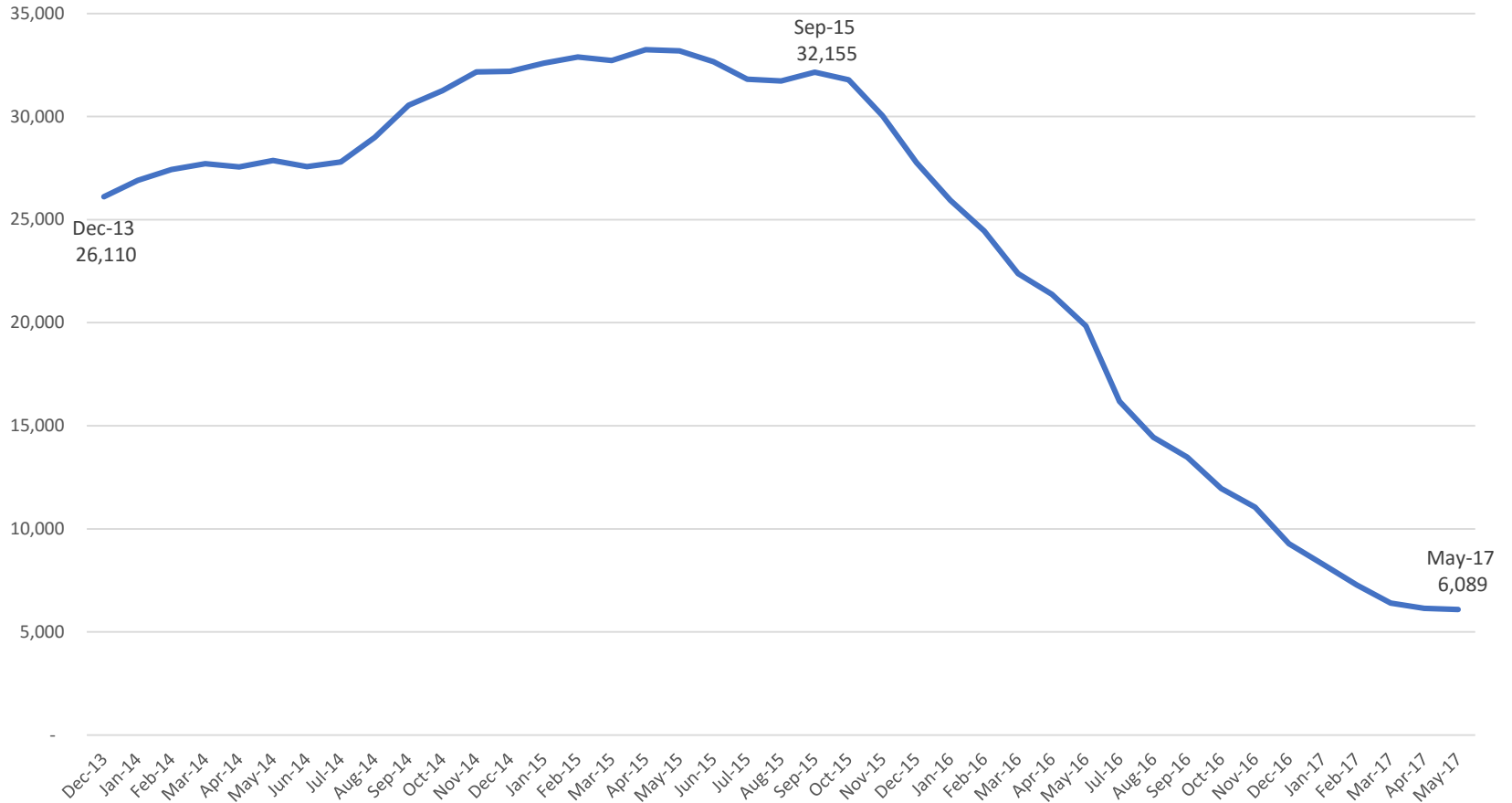

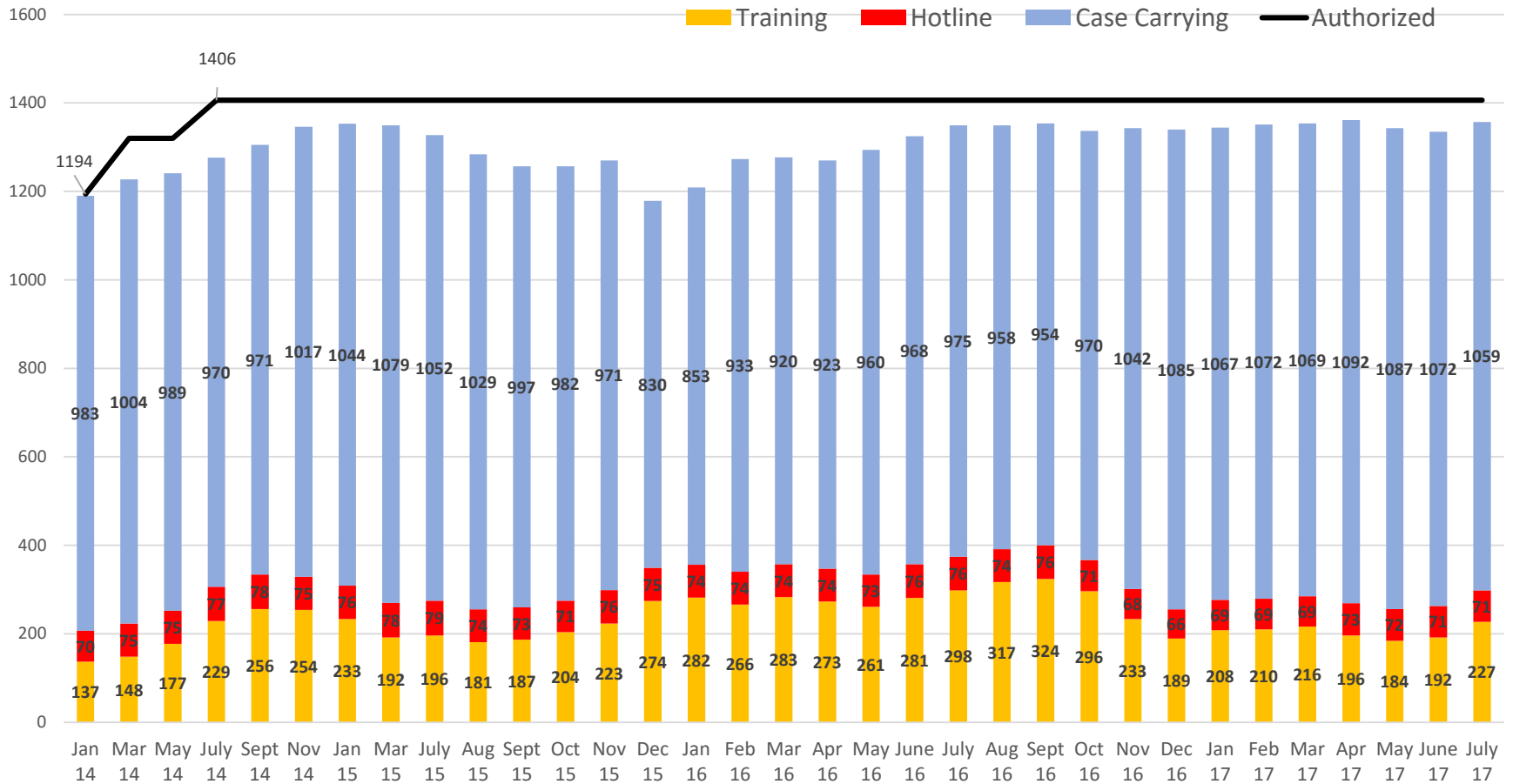

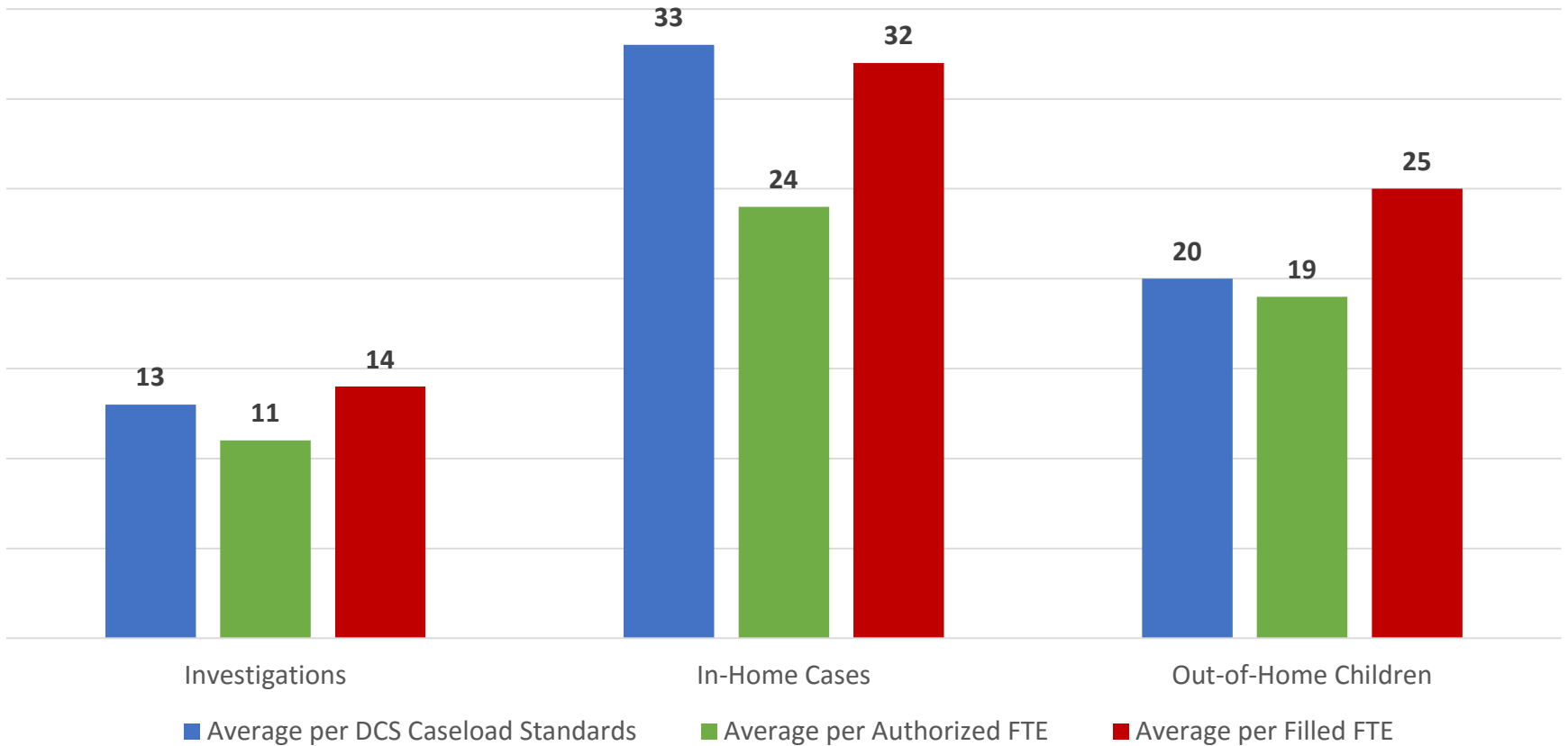

## Caseworker Workload Compared to Standards and Budgeted Positions

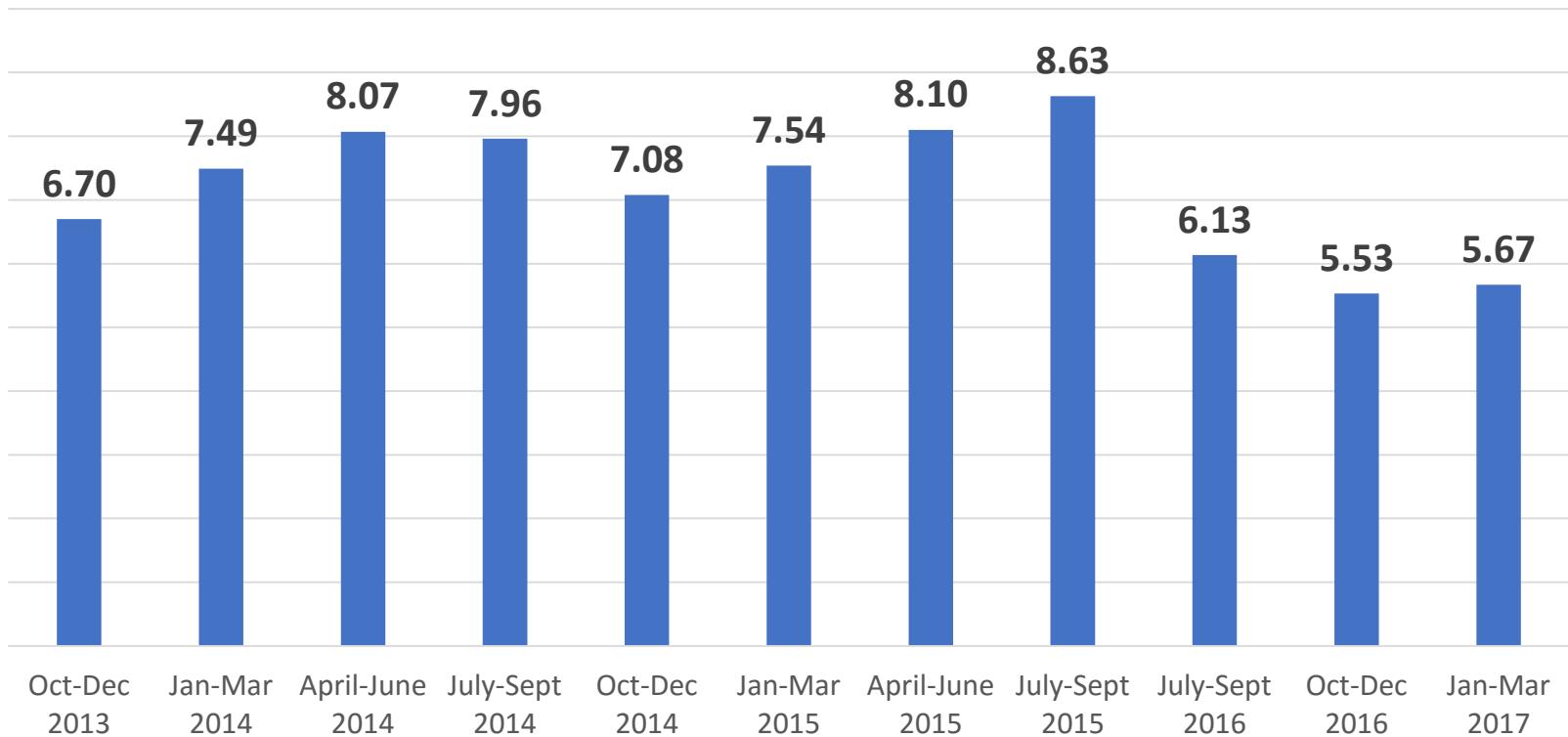

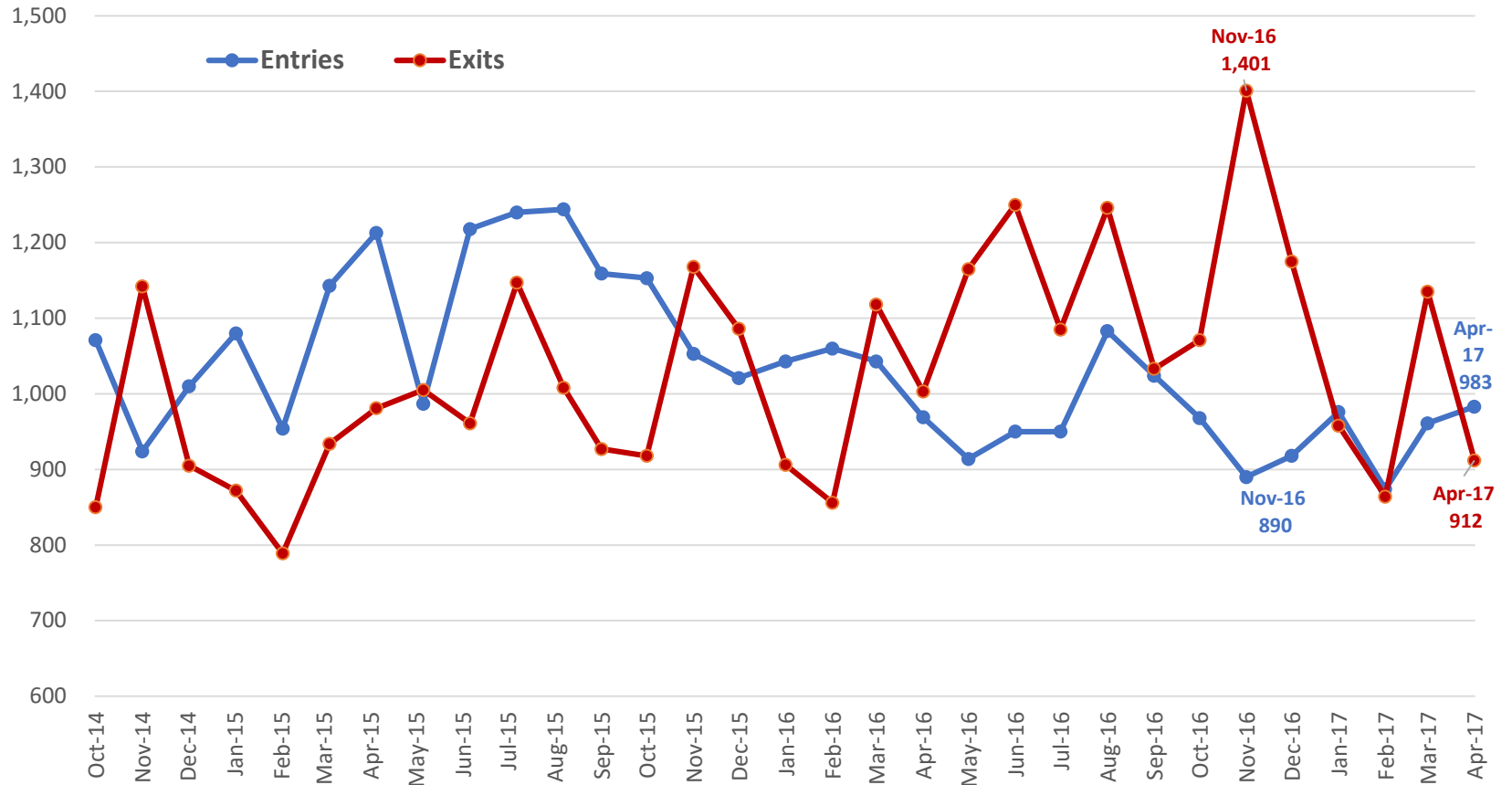
## FOSTER CARE ENTRY RATE PER 1,000 CHILD POPULATION

## CHILDREN ENTERING FOSTER CARE COMPARED TO CHILDREN EXITING FOSTER CARE

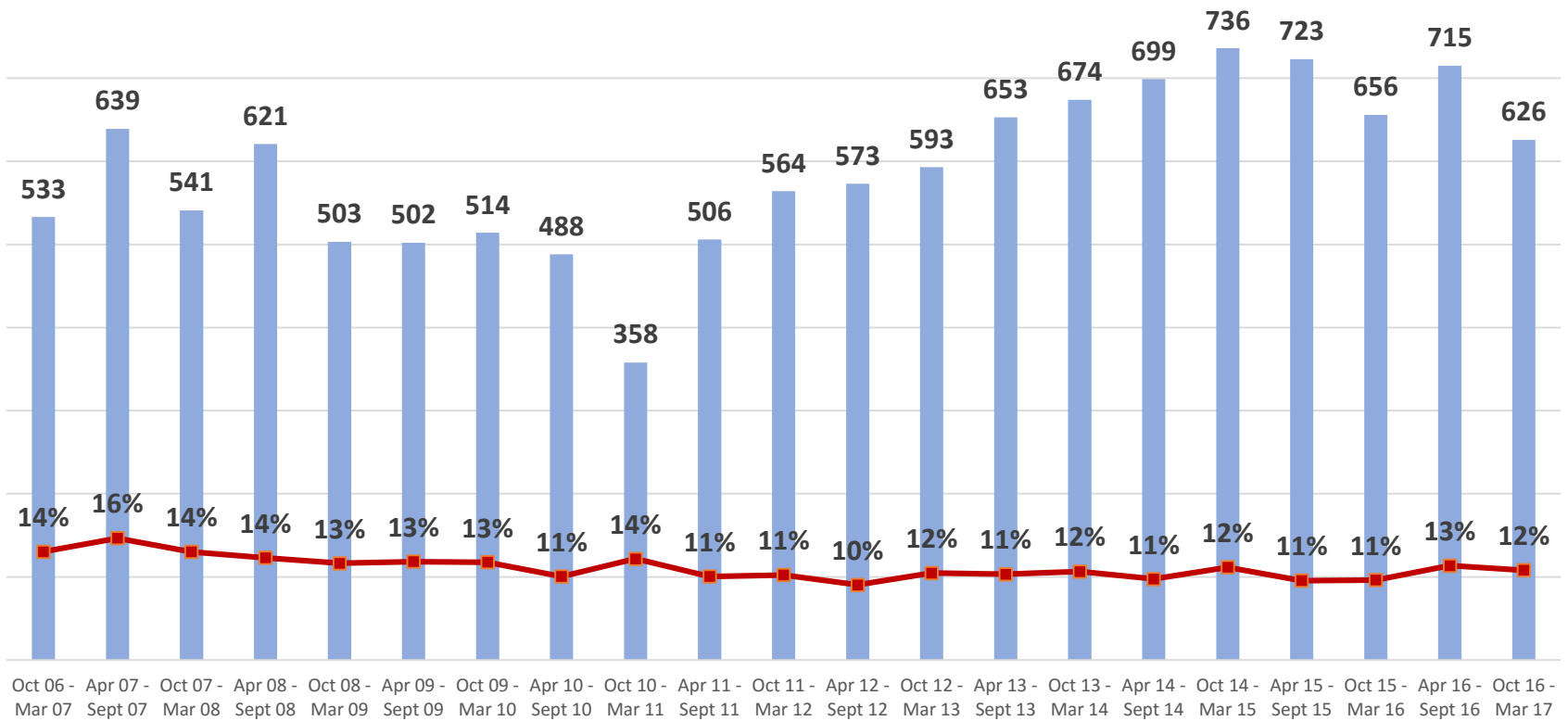

## KIDS ENTERING FOSTER CARE WITH A PREVIOUS REMOVAL IN THE LAST 24 MONTHS



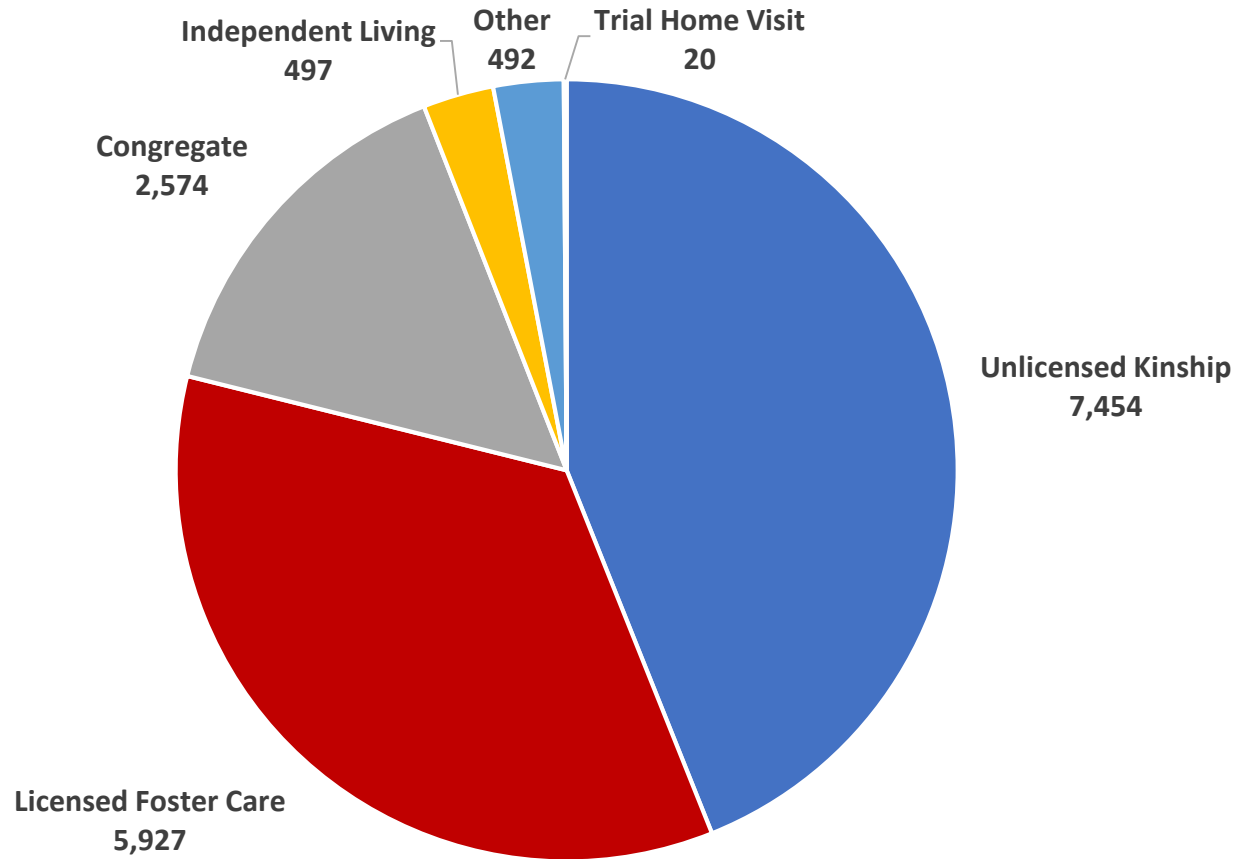

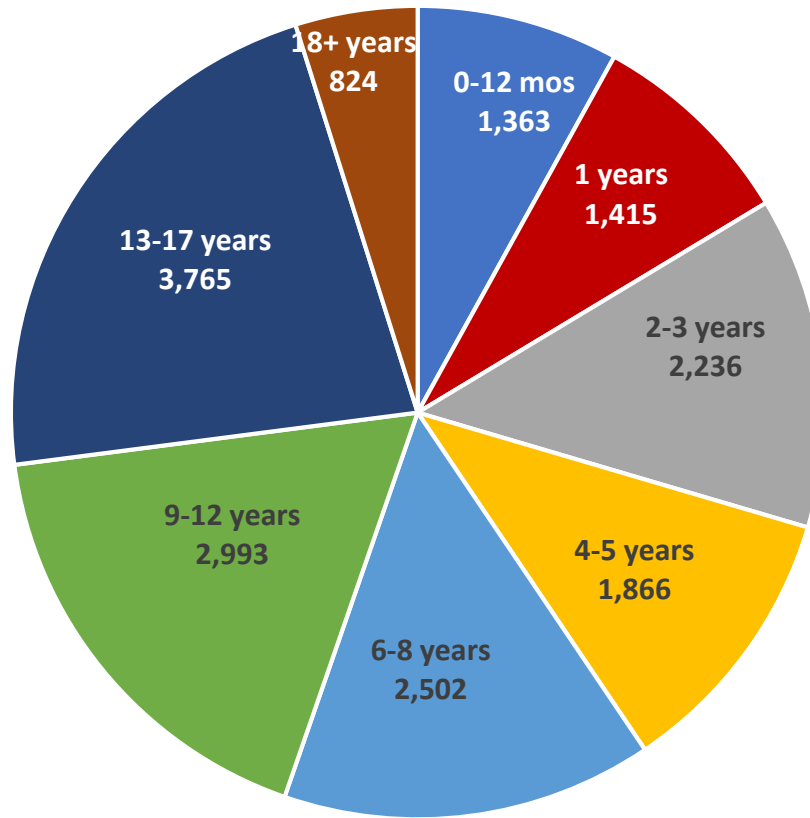

April 2017

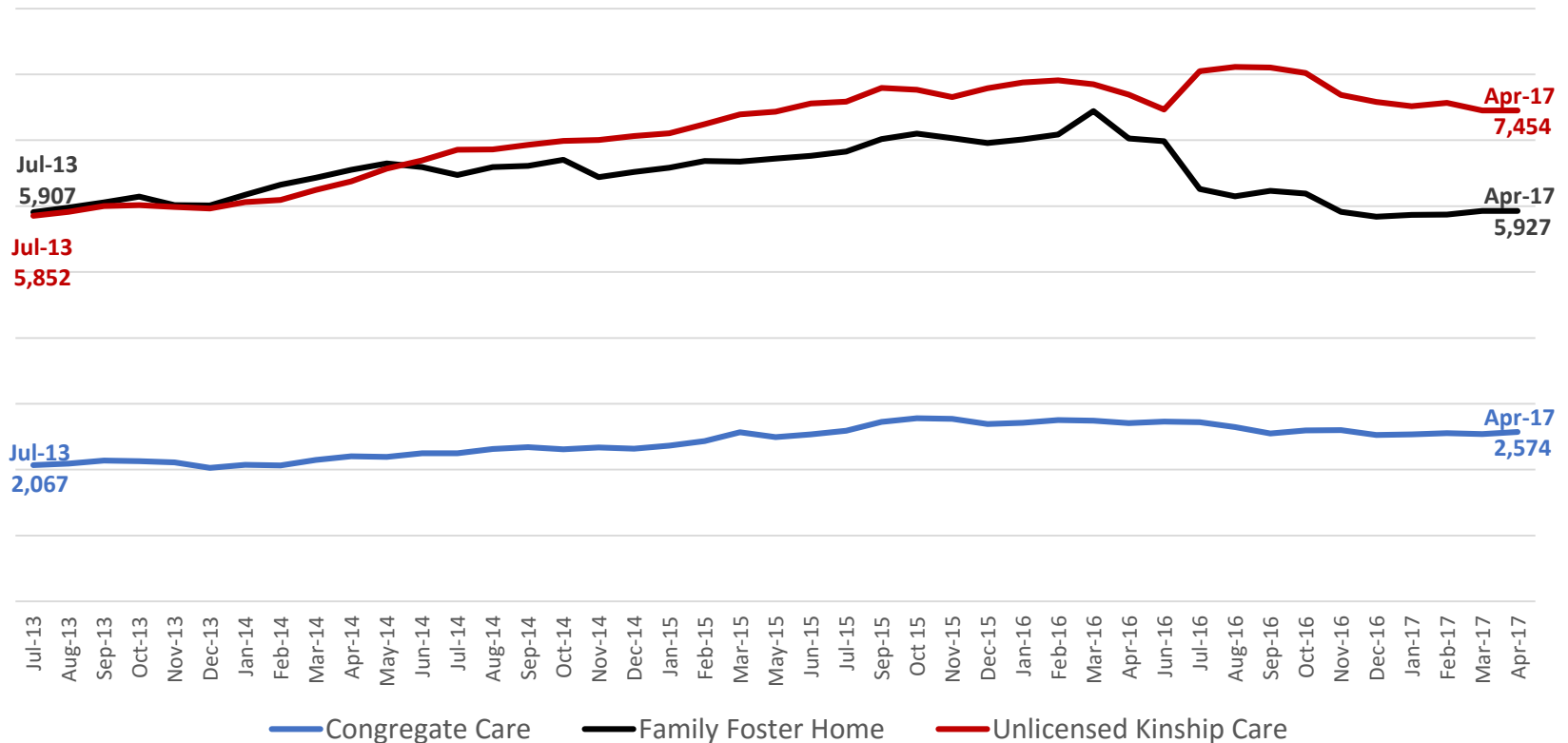

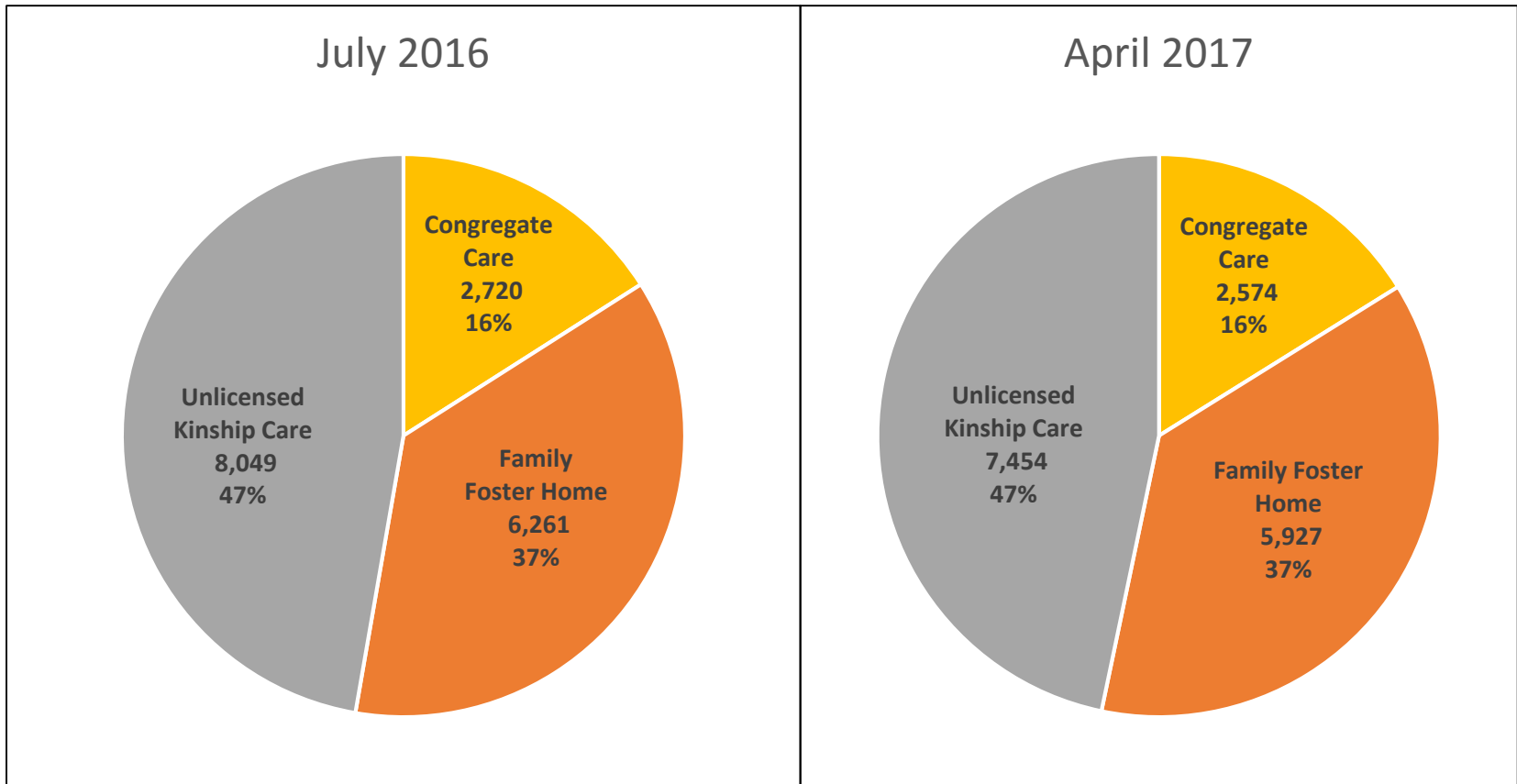

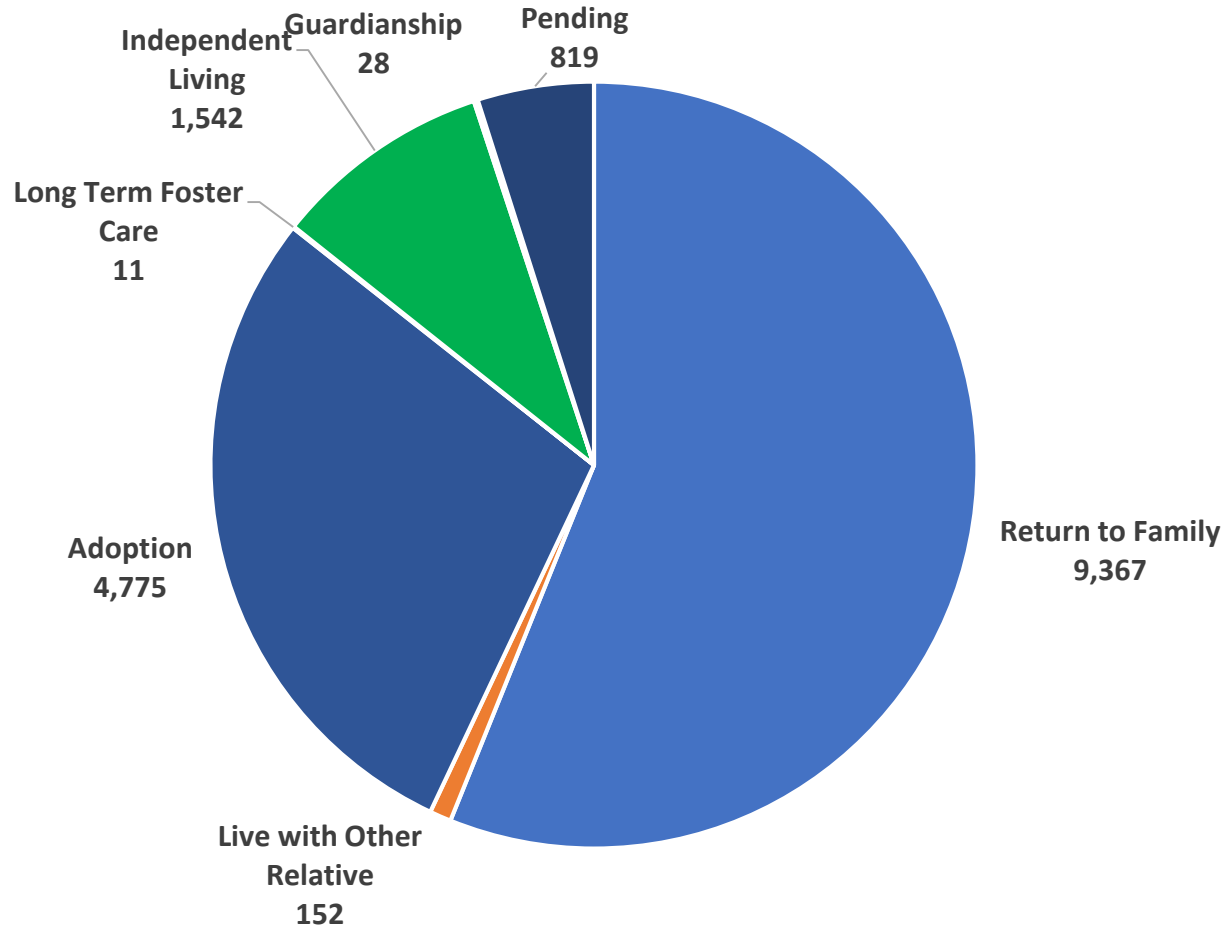

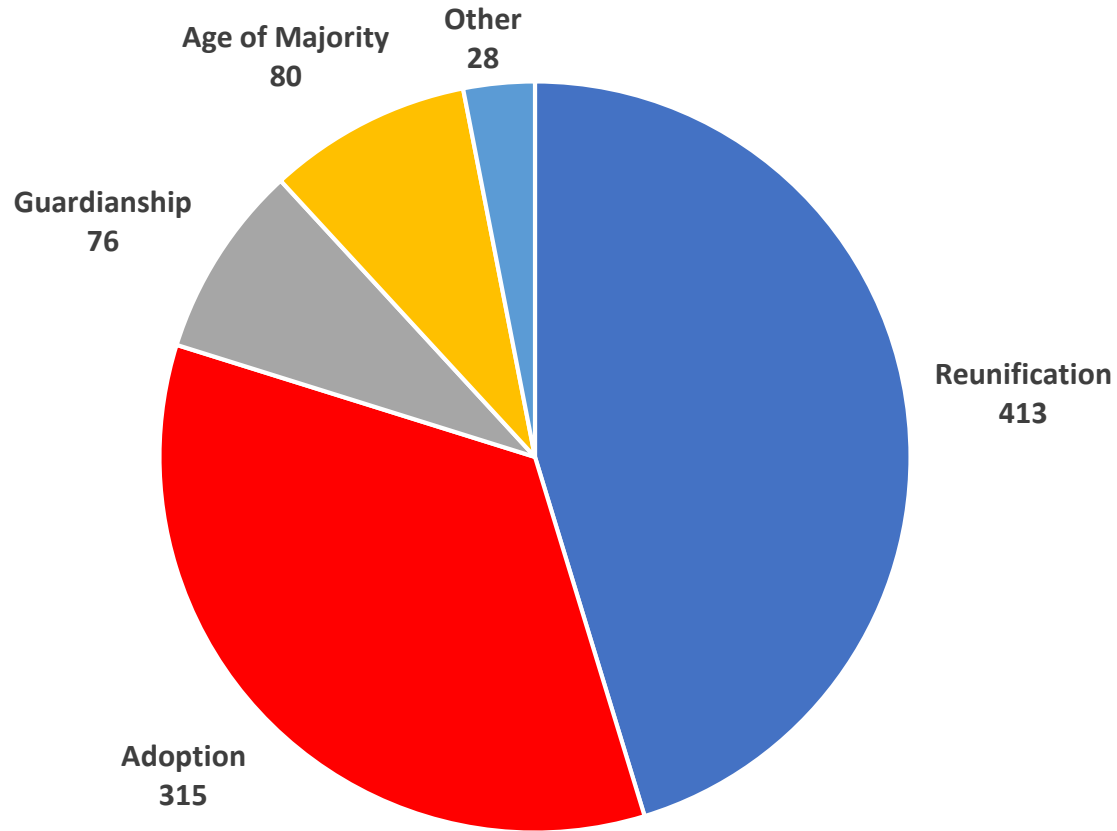

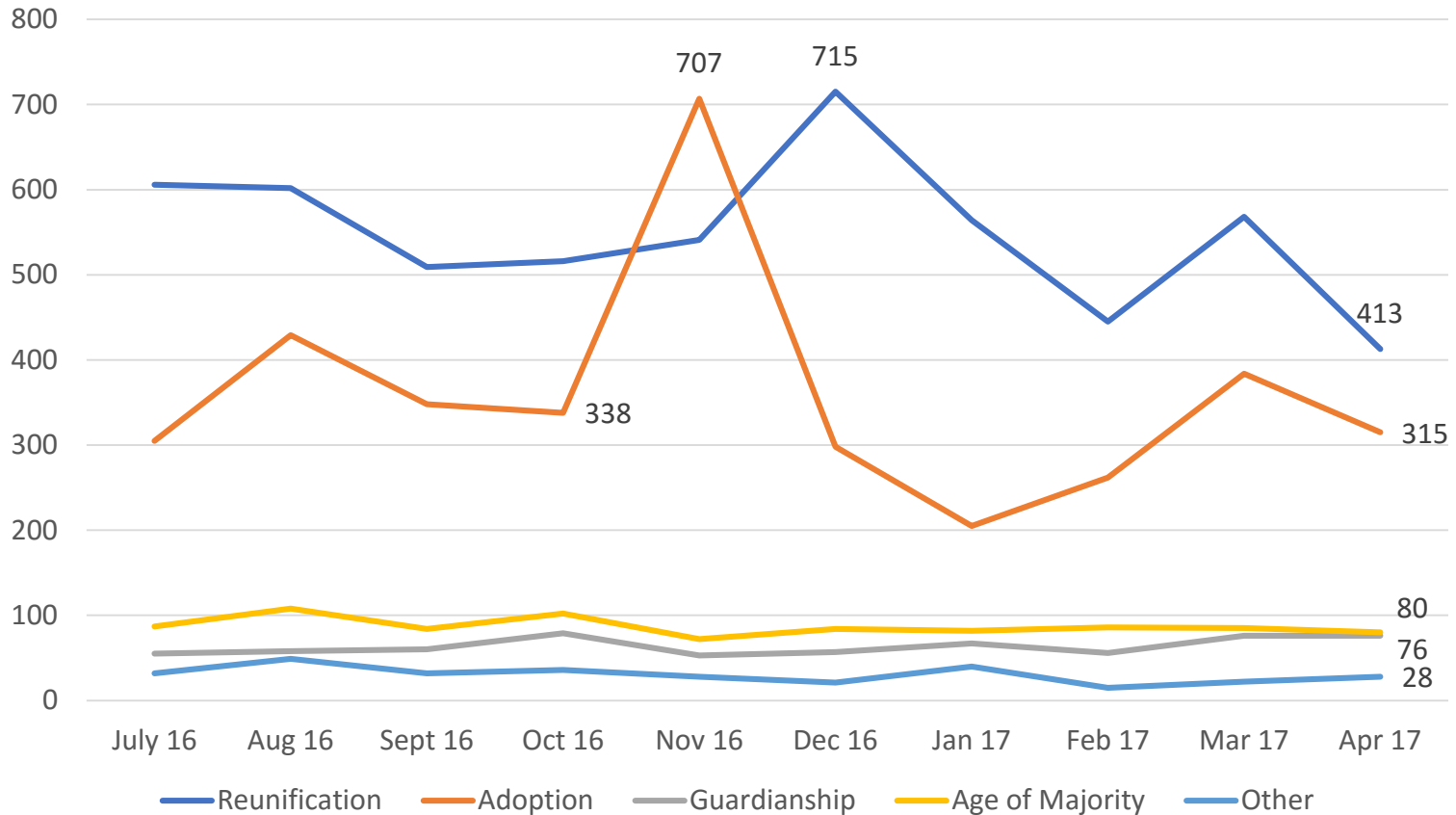

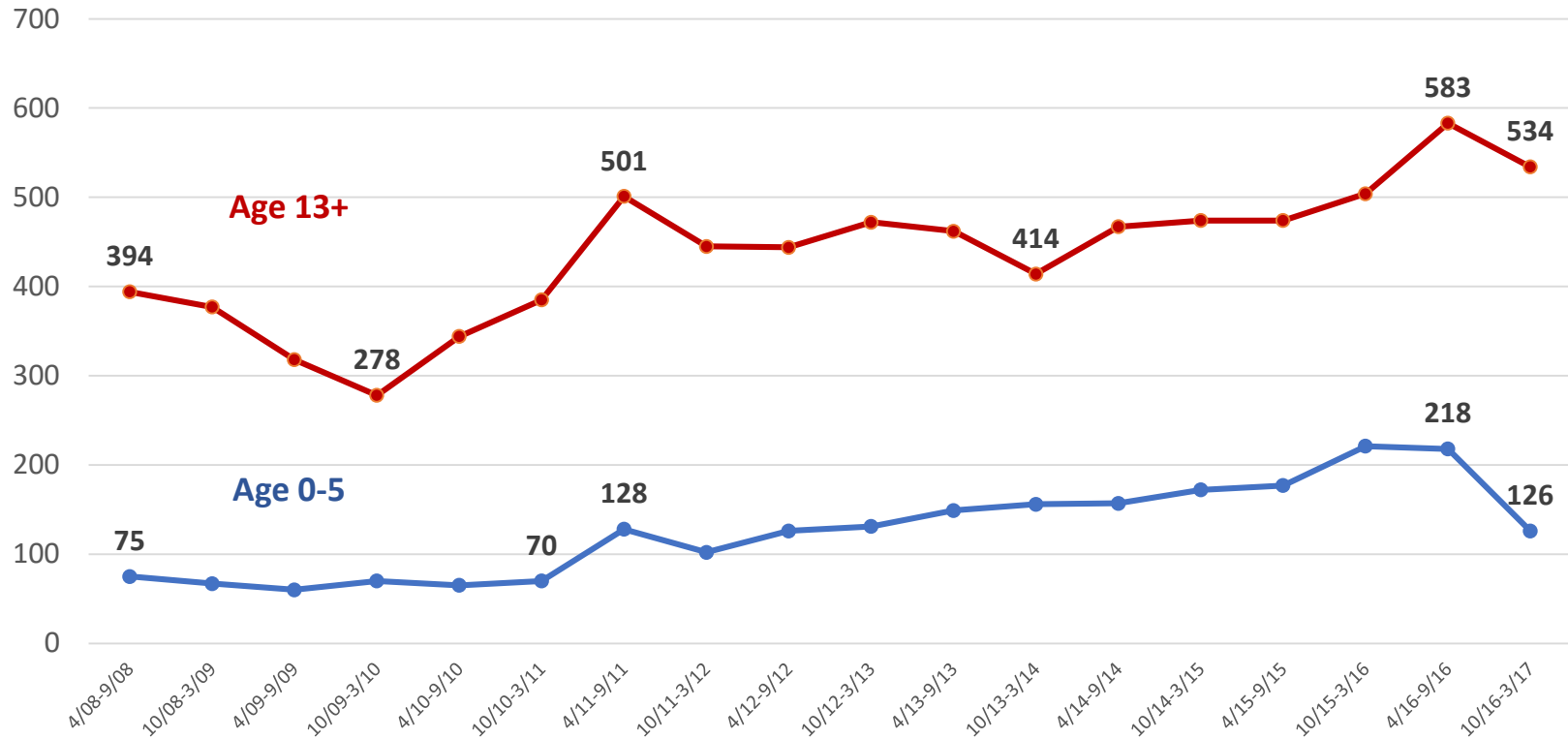
